# Murrindindi Matters Community Local Law



Notice is hereby given that Murrindindi Shire Council ('Council'), at its Ordinary Meeting on 24 September 2012, resolved to make Community Local Law 2012 pursuant to section 119 of the *Local Government Act 1989*.

The purpose of the Community Local Law is to regulate:

Peace, order and good government of the municipality;  
A safe and healthy environment so that the community can enjoy a quality of life that meets its expectations;  
The safe and fair use and enjoyment of public places;  
The protection and enhancement of the amenity and environment of the municipality;  
A fair and reasonable use and enjoyment of private land; and  
A uniform and fair administration of the Local Law.

Consistent with State Government Guidelines, Council has combined its existing local laws (excluding its Governance Local Law) into a new format Community Local Law. This is to make the laws easier to access and follow by the public, and more efficient to administer by the Council.

The general purport of the Community Local Law 2012 is:

- Part 1 - Preliminary matters
- Part 2 - Safety of people and property
- Part 3 - Streets and Roads
- Part 4 - Administration
- Part 5 - Enforcement

The Community Local Law 2012 comes into effect on 24 September 2012.

## Memorial project moves to next community consultation stage



The Murrindindi community will have the opportunity to discuss the responses to the Bushfire Memorials Project and to contribute to developing the design brief, in community meetings and further consultations to be held in late October.

Mayor John Walsh said the responses to the community consultation conducted by the Memorials Working Group last year were rich and varied.

"Most respondents agreed that they wanted a memorial – and that it should express a sense of remembrance, respect and honour of those who have been lost, and to also emphasise the themes of survival, resilience and hope," Cr Walsh said.

It was clear that the community wants the memorials to be sited in an area of natural beauty that allows quiet reflection, that is easy to access but not in a busy central location. Some residents were supportive of two significant memorials on each side of the shire, some preferred a small memorial in each affected township – while others wanted a combination of both.

The next stage is to explore the many suggestions and ideas related to the specific nature of the memorials, where they should be sited, and what elements they should incorporate.

Amongst these are the questions of how to memorialise the individuals lost in the fires, as well as how to recognise the loss of much-loved pets, of farm animals and wildlife, and the impact of the fires on local landscapes.

"The fires affected the communities in so many different ways and it is important that a memorial is able to encapsulate those varied experiences," Cr Walsh said.

The working group acknowledges that some residents may be exhausted and emotionally worn out by the activity of disaster recovery. But the opportunity to memorialise is an important part of putting things into the past, according to Dr Rob Gordon, a psychologist with many years experience in helping communities recover from disasters.

"A memorial is a physical representation of an experience that is part of our history - and that has made us who we are today. It helps us recognise this experience as part of our identity," Dr Gordon said.

This next consultation stage will give residents the opportunity to contribute their words, images and thoughts to be incorporated into the design process.

"There are no decisions at this stage. We want to talk about the options. It is the next stage of the journey," Cr Walsh said.

Information sessions will be held either side of the shire on Sunday 21 October 2012.
