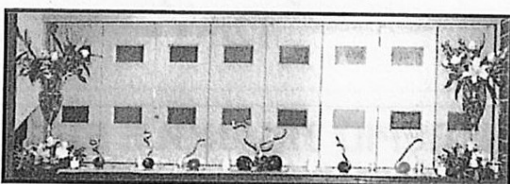

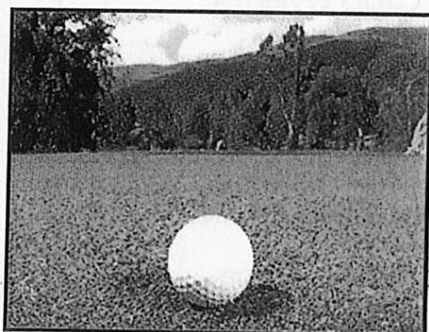

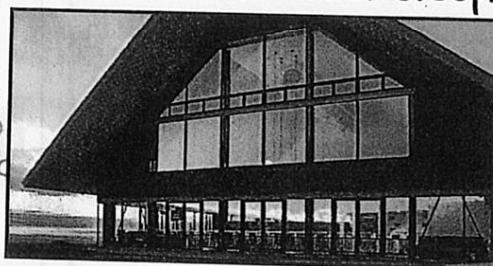

It's all about quality for our Aged and Disability services

An onsite quality review of the Aged and Disability support services provided by Murrindindi Shire Council has resulted in a positive report.

General Manager Corporate and Community Services, Mr Rob Cherry said that the review found Council's support of its Aged and Disability service users to be of a high standard.

"The reviewers were very positive about what we are doing but also gave us several ideas on how we could improve the services we provide to the community," Mr Cherry said.

"Our Aged and Disability team supports frail aged people as well as people with a disability and their carers to stay active, independent and living at home for as long as possible. The services we provide include home care, personal care, home maintenance, delivered and centre based meals, social support programs and respite.

"Our service is funded by both the state and commonwealth and representatives from both levels of government visited us to conduct the onsite review. They looked at whether we manage our services effectively, whether we provide the right services to eligible people and how we provide service users with information about their rights and responsibilities.

"One of the suggestions put forward was for us to find out more about what our clients think of our services and whether they think that their needs are being met. We are keen to do this and will be distributing a questionnaire to establish how people think we are performing. The process will be anonymous and we encourage recipients of this questionnaire to complete the form and return it to us as all feedback we receive will assist us in improving what we do," Mr Cherry said.

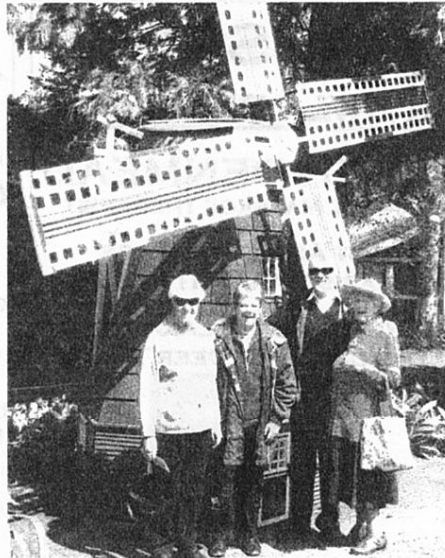

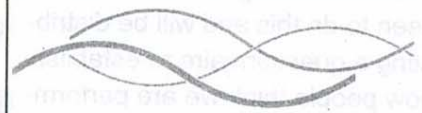

How to return your ballot paper

During October from Friday 19th to Sunday 21st, Upper Goulburn Community Radio Inc. (UGFM - Radio Murrindindi) is holding a 'Radiothon' to increase the membership of the station. 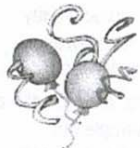
