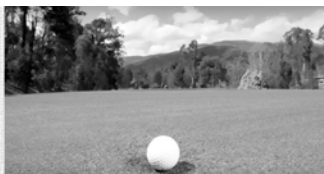

**Fox control – Lake Eildon National Park, Big River State forest, Rubicon State forest, Cathedral Range State Park, Marysville State forest, Yarra Ranges National Park and Toolangi State forest**

The Department of Sustainability and Environment and Parks Victoria are committed to protecting and enhancing the natural values of parks, reserves and state forests across the state. Examples of this conservation management are the control of introduced plant and animal species which can impact on these values.

As part of an ongoing strategy, notice is hereby given that the Department of Sustainability and Environment will be laying buried baits containing sodium fluoroacetate (1080 poison) on public land for the control of foxes. Baits containing 1080 poison will be laid from **Monday 14th January until Friday 13th December 2013.**

Baits will be laid at strategic sites and other known areas of fox habitat within the above mentioned forests and parks, within the vicinity of townships Eildon, Rubicon, Taggerty, Buxton, Marysville, Narbethong, Healesville, Warburton and Toolangi.

1080 poison signs will be posted throughout the baited areas and members of the public who are living, visiting or working in the above named areas are advised to take particular care not to disturb or interfere with bait stations. Domestic dogs and cats are particularly susceptible to 1080 poison and should be under effective control, muzzled or kept away from the poisoned areas.

## MAYOR'S CHAIR

After an increase in tourist numbers shire wide in 2012, there has been a drop off in some locations to this point this year. The figures suggest that visitor numbers are up significantly at attractions such as Lake Eildon but down in some non water based locations including Marysville. Visitor numbers at the Cathedral Ranges State Park are similar to last year.

It is gratifying to see the reports of increased visitors in many locations, however it is important that we put our minds to the lower numbers as this is where the improvements can be made. There is a view held by some that fire always comes with hot weather within our Shire. To combat this we need to do a couple of things.

Firstly we need to educate the tourist market to have a broader picture of the enjoyment that's available in our region during hot weather. There are still cool walks and rivers to enjoy. There are picnic race meetings at Yea and Alexandra with markets, good food and art shows throughout. And of course there is all the summer fun being enjoyed by thousands of visitors and locals alike on Lake Eildon and along the Goulburn River.

We also need to project a new image that counters the current misconception.

We have tremendous facilities for cycling activities. With the Rail Trail, township trails and mountain bike courses adding to excellent road riding opportunities, we need to promote ourselves as a bike friendly area that has everything so close to the metropolitan area.

With Yea already one of the three Citaslow accredited towns within Australia, it can provide the nucleus for the whole Shire to be so recognized. Throughout the Shire we already have so many businesses, farmers and artists following or providing the slow-food experience, relaxed lifestyles with local produce, art and wine that Citaslow represents. Being the first Citaslow Shire in the world would bring international recognition for all the right reasons. It would take some work but it can be done.

In Murrindindi, we have the Yin and the Yang. We have extreme adventure and we have relaxed living. We have fast and we have slow. We cater for every need. We must work together to promote these aspects of our lives and so allow the world to see a real picture of the Shire that crowds out images of our recent past.
