Autumn Domestic Firewood Collection Season Starts

Autumn domestic firewood collection season will now start this Friday

The Autumn 2013 Firewood Collection Season will now begin this Friday (8/3/13) after significant fires were contained across Victoria and recent rainfall in parts of the state.

Department of Sustainability and Environment (DSE) Statewide Land and Fire Coordinator Rob Price said a combination of large going fires, dry conditions and a risk to public safety had contributed to a recent decision to delay the opening of the firewood season until 15 March, except for far East Gippsland.

"Since then all of the going fires have been contained and, combined with the rain, the conditions in our forests are now suitable for firewood collection to commence at the end of the week," Mr Price said.

"We appreciate the patience of the community while DSE and Parks Victoria have been monitoring the fire risk in an effort to make sure firewood collection is conducted as safely as possible."

"The public will be able to collect firewood from 8 March in designated domestic firewood collection areas across Victoria as they have been able to do in far East Gippsland since 1 March."

DSE and Parks Victoria staff will be patrolling parks, forests and reserves to ensure people are doing the right thing.

Firewood collection is only permitted during designated times of the year and from designated firewood collection areas.

Typical on the spot fines are around \$560. Offences that go to court may be liable for fines up to \$7042, one year imprisonment or both.

MAYOR'S CHAIR

I was recently asked about good sights and activities in Washington DC. It has been more than three years since my last visit. I started to list all my favourite haunts then realized that given the passage of time, the city will have changed and so I had better check my facts.

It reminded me that as I had journeyed through my career in the Army, then in IT and risk management most of the progression was accompanied by a feeling of achievement together with an understanding that within a short period of time my successors would have to face new circumstances and using their different approaches would inevitably change what I had left behind. I would see such changes as good or bad. But whatever the case before I could make any real judgment I needed to get up to date evidence and not just rely on old memories.

Linked to this was also the realisation that it takes a lot of effort to keep up to date if you are not in the daily loop.

Further, if one is going to comment in public, in the hope of improving the way in which an organisation or person is performing, there is a need to be accurate and to weigh up whether such publicity will help a positive change or just add negativity.

In reaction to current changes there are some, who have not brought themselves up to date, but who see fit to be publicly negative about the progress of the shire.

While any initial credence crumbles away as the true situation is revealed, the approach creates a barrier for constructive interchange and it diminishes Murrindi in the eyes of people outside the shire whom we are trying to attract. A better way is to contact your Councillors or Council Management, have a chat and get the full, up-to-date, picture.

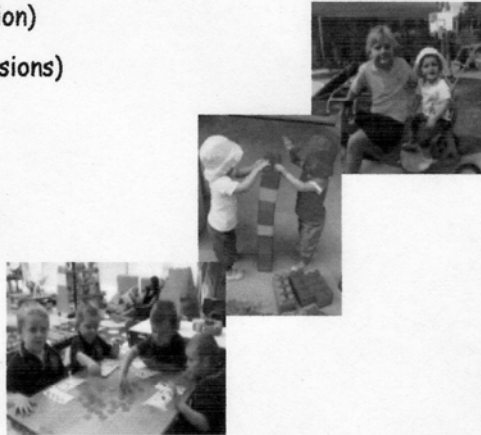

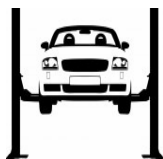

Y Water Centre at Yea Wetlands

Plans for the new \$1.9 million Y Water Centre at Yea Wetlands have been unveiled, including the new name for the environmentally significant precinct.

The major project, at the eastern entrance to the Yea township, will include a Visitor Information Centre and interactive environmental interpretive displays that tell the story of the Yea Wetlands and the life forms it supports.

Council's Wetlands project representative Cr John Kennedy said the plans highlighted a venue that would raise awareness of the environmental significance of the wetlands, support community events, provide an outstanding facility to promote tourism and most importantly provide a state-of-the-art interpretive hub that can be expanded and developed as a learning resource centre.

"It was pleasing to see the community come to see the plans as part of a drop in session on Tuesday evening," Cr Kennedy said.

"It was a chance for them to see first-hand the architectural drawings for the centre, meet with the designers, the Wetlands Committee members, Council staff and Wetlands Trust representatives and discover the Y Water Centre at Yea Wetlands naming and branding.

"It was also an opportunity to see a three dimensional illustration of some of the key interpretive components of the centre."

Capital funding for the centre has been secured through the State Government and Melbourne Water's Regional Benefits Grants. Through the generosity and efforts of the local community, the Yea Wetlands Trust has raised an additional \$200,000 that will be put towards the interpretive content and environmental learning programs that will be delivered through the centre.

From its inception this project has been community driven. It is an initiative led by the committee and the trust with support from Murrindindi Shire Council and the Yea Business and Tourism Association (YBTA).

Murrindindi Shire Council will assume ownership of the building once completed and has established a Project Control Group to oversee the project. Representatives on the group have been drawn from the Wetlands Committee and Trust, Yea Business and Tourism Association as well as representatives from Regional Development Victoria and Council.

While the centre's construction does not require a financial contribution from Council, a commitment has been made to support the ongoing operations of the Visitor Information Centre through staffing and assistance to meet initial start-up costs.

"The design work has been completed by Zen Architects in consultation with the project control group, while the interpretive work continues to be developed by Hierophant Communications.

"We are very excited with the development and look forward to creating opportunities for further community involvement as the project progresses to completion," Cr Kennedy said.

Council is currently calling for expression of interest from builders with a
