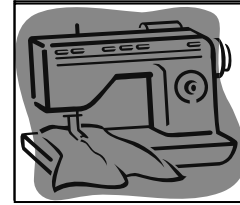
Whether these are paid or volunteer roles, our expectations are such that we simply cannot imagine being without them at all times.

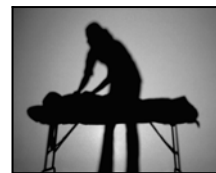

Council adopts Code Red Policy

Murrindindi Shire Council will implement a number of changes to its operations when Code Red Days are declared in the North Central Fire Ban District.

The policy is aimed to ensure that Council staff, its volunteers and members of the public are not placed in situations of undue risk on Code Red Days when conducting Council business or accessing services.

Mayor Margaret Rae said the clear message remained on a Code Red Day announcement that people should enact their bushfire survival plans and leave areas of high bushfire risk, either the night before, or early in the morning.

"The policy recognises Council is likely to operate with altered or reduced service levels. We are talking about very dangerous fire weather that poses extreme risks to life and property should a fire start," Cr Rae said.

On CODE RED DAYS:

Council Offices: As far as practicable Council will maintain access to customer services from the Alexandra, Kinglake and Yea Council offices. Murrindindi Library services will also operate, where practicable, during normal opening hours at the Alexandra, Kinglake and Yea branches.

Travel and Meetings: All non-essential travel and meetings will be cancelled, including Ordinary or Special Council meetings and meetings of delegated committees if scheduled. Mobile library services, all outdoor works and non-essential property inspections will also be cancelled, with staff redeployed to emergency planning and stand-by arrangements.

Local Laws: Officers will continue to respond to emergency callouts where there is imminent danger to human life. All non-essential services will be postponed.

Resource Recovery Centres (RRCs): All RRCs and Alexandra Landfill will be closed.

Kerbside Waste Collection: Waste collections will take place where practicable, but may commence earlier than usual on these days

Community Services:

Family Day Care and In Home Care will operate in accordance with Department of Education and Early Childhood Development directives to local primary and secondary education facilities. Child care will continue to be offered, subject to educator availability, in Eildon, Alexandra and Yea. Services based in areas where local schools are directed to close on code red days will not operate.

Maternal and Child Health Services in Yea and Alexandra will operate as normal (subject to staff availability) Services will not operate in Eildon, Toolangi, Marysville, Kinglake and Flowerdale due to elevated risk associated with travelling.

Council's Aged and Disability Services will be restricted to essential services. Where possible, contact will be made with vulnerable clients informing them of service restrictions.

Pools, Parks and Recreation: Alexandra and Yea swimming pools will be the only pools to operate on Code Red Days. Council managed outdoor recreation reserves, parks and the Great Victorian Rail Trail will remain open.

Updated Information: Council will continue to update its website at www.murrindindi.vic.gov.au where practicable.

"This policy is about protecting our staff and the community. We do not want to see people put at risk during the State's highest Fire Danger Rating day," Cr Rae said

"We also want to ensure that fires do not accidentally start due to our outdoor operations.

"It also ensures sufficient staff resources can be re-deployed to emergency response planning functions and, in the event of a fire event, provide support to fire combating agencies and emergency relief centres."

The Department of Environment and Primary Industries and Parks Victoria are committed to protecting and enhancing the natural values of parks, reserves and state forests across the state. Examples of this conservation management are the control of introduced plant and animal species which can impact on these values.

As part of an ongoing strategy, the Department of Environment and Primary Industries will be laying buried baits containing sodium fluoroacetate (1080 poison) on public land for the control of foxes. Baiting will commence **Monday 13th January 2014** and will continue until **Friday 19th December 2014**.

Baits will be laid at strategic sites and other known areas of fox habitat within the above mentioned forests and parks, and within the vicinity of townships Eildon, Rubicon, Taggerty, Buxton, Marysville, Narbethong, Healesville, Warburton and Toolangi.

1080 poison signs will be posted throughout the baited areas and members of the public who are living, visiting or working in the above named areas are advised to take particular care not to disturb or interfere with bait stations. Domestic dogs and cats are particularly susceptible to 1080 poison and should be under effective control, muzzled or kept away from the poisoned areas.
