## Farmers Need our help

Hope you all remember the Fund-raiser which we run after the help we received from Black Saturday, to help the small rural town of Alpha which has become close to my heart, that was hit twice by the Floods, now they are facing the worst drought possible. But like most people on the land we never hear much about it. What I am hoping to achieve is to be able to send pamper packs or some items for the Children, as these are the items that can not be supplied as the family budgets to not extend to such items. As a Mother I know most women put there family 1st and themselves last to receive, with the help of our communities I would love once again to help them out, with your help I know we can make a difference to their lives.

Below are three items that have been posted on Facebook ( Angels for Alpha) which I have joined

70% of Queensland in the grips of a horrendous drought. Alpha is one such town that we would like to help. It is located between Emerald and Barcaldine in a big cattle producing area of Queensland. I am asking the wider community to make heart felt donations of non-perishable food items, household items (cleaning products), shoes in excellent conditions, clothing (new-second hand no stained, torn, stretched, holey items), craft/sewing items, stationery/craft items for kids all ages, bloke interest items, pet products and cash donations can be made to the Uniting churches of Laidley or Hatton Vale.

This is an exert of an email I re-

ceived from a farmer at Alpha. She has given me the permission to put this out to the community.

One thing that gets overlooked when these types of events happen is the bank balance!!! Some people may have been feeding stock for months even a year or more so they have extended the overdrafts with their banks to very scary figures and this does not get fixed overnight with rainfall. The bank balances can only recover with a few years of good cattle prices and then you have to get the more continued rain to keep the cattle fattening. That is the huge misconception, a lot of people think once there has been good rain that everything is fixed. Yes it makes you feel a lot better and the pressure has eased but at the end of the day, there is still a huge debt that has to be re-paid to the banks plus interest for all the money they have lent you to feed cattle, cart water etc. The other important factor is that a lot of people in the very western Qld country had to de-stock their places and so now IF THEY HAVE HAD RAIN, they will have to wait for the grass to grow and then try and find the money to re-stock their land with breeders/cattle. Prices usually rise a little with rain around so that will make re-stocking very expensive for people who are battling with money issues and in a lot of cases, depression. S. McKeering

## Burning continues despite high rainfall

Despite significant rainfall across the Hume Region, the Department of Environment and Primary Industries (DEPI) and Parks Victoria continue to carry out planned burns when weather and fuel conditions are favourable. DEPI's Manager Planned Burning, Hume, Paul O'Connor, said: "In the past week we have had between 50mm and 150mm of rainfall across our region which has significantly increased moisture levels in forested areas," he said.

"This has had a significant impact on our ability to conduct burns in high elevation forest areas. These areas are unlikely to be suitable for burning this autumn.

"Our focus at the present time is lower elevation forest areas where the fuels dry out faster and provide opportunities to burn. Some of these areas will be closer to townships and farmland.

"So far this year we have carried out burns over an area of 7000 hectares of public land. We will continue to seek opportunities to continue our burning program whenever weather and fuel conditions are suitable.

"Weather and fuel conditions dictate when we can burn and plans can change at short notice, so when we get an opportunity to carry out burning we make sure we are ready and prepared to do so."

A number of burns were undertaken successfully in the Goulburn Fire District this week near Benalla and will be patrolled over the coming days.

The following burns are also planned during the coming days:

- Walshes Road: 406 hectare fuel reduction burn, 7km north west of Jamieson.
- Knockwood: Snake Edwards Divide Link Track: 2793 hectare fuel reduction burn, Knockwood.

Residents and visitors in Jamieson, Mansfield and surrounding townships may see smoke from these burns.

"Planned burning is part of an ongoing program to reduce bushfire risk to local communities, property and the environment," Mr O'Connor said.

If people experience any symptoms that may be due to smoke exposure, they should seek medical advice or call Nurse-on-Call on 1300 606 024.

## Amnesty period on open air burning in residential areas 5 – 19 May 2014

The CFA's Declared Fire Danger Period concluded on 22 April 2014.

Murrindindi Shire Council and the Municipal Fire Management Planning Committee has granted a fire amnesty period from the 5 May - 19 May 2014, to allow vegetation material such as tree limbs, cuttings and dried leaves to be burnt in residential areas without the need to obtain a permit.

Residents are encouraged to carry out controlled burning to remove any vegetation that has accumulated over the summer months.

Fires must be no greater than 1 metre in diameter or 1 metre high in size.

Council's Community Local Law prohibits lighting fires that cause a nuisance, such as excessive smoke.

No windrows are to be lit without a permit in residential areas.

**For those who do not wish to burn-off, Council is providing free green waste disposal at all Resource Recovery Centres from 5 May to 19 May 2014.**
