## Investing in the Marysville and Triangle communities

THE communities of the Marysville and Triangle areas received a boost when the Deputy Premier Peter Ryan announced the State Government's injection of \$975,000 for the Marysville and Triangle Community Foundation (MTCF) on Saturday, September 6.

The funds were raised from the sale of assets in Marysville which had been provided to the community following the 2009 bushfires. The State Government has now allocated a portion of the sales of these assets to be returned to the local community through the MTCF.

The chairperson of the MTCF, Mr Tony Thompson said the Foundation was thrilled to receive the funds on behalf of the community. "The funds will be invested by the Foundation for the ongoing benefit and development of the Triangle communities. A new fund, to be known as the Triangle Community Development Fund, will be established by the Foundation with the full amount being invested and the interest earned put towards community projects" Mr Thompson said.

Last week the Foundation announced the opening of the first round of community grants from its Bushfire Recovery Fund. The Bushfire Recovery Fund was established through funds received from the

Victorian Bushfire Appeal Fund (VBAF). The Bushfire Recovery Fund grants program will be used to provide assistance to those affected by the 2009 bushfires in Murrindindi Shire. The grant round was opened on 10 September and applications must be received by 7 November 2014. "Applications for grants from the Bushfire Recovery Fund must be submitted on line through the Foundation's website" said the MTCF Executive Officer, Robyn Hill. "You will also find tips for completing the application form and a guide to navigating through the on line system

on our website".

The Marysville and Triangle Community Foundation's vision is to build a legacy for a vibrant, healthy and resilient future across the communities of Murrindindi.

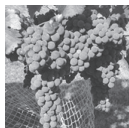

## Mayor's Chair by Cr Margaret Rae

This week sees the celebration of Australian Citizenship Day on 17 September - an annual event since 2001 - though I suspect it has a tendency to 'fly under the radar'.

This special day was launched in order to increase community awareness of Australian Citizenship. It was established in response to a recommendation by the Australian Citizenship Council and now provides a main focus for community related activities and celebrations. The actual date was chosen because it was the date on which the Nationality and Citizenship Act 1948 was renamed the Australian Citizenship Act 1948.

Many Councils hold Australian Citizenship ceremonies on this day - and this year we will do the same by conducting a ceremony to welcome two new citizens at our Kinglake offices. Citizenship ceremonies are also held throughout the year, with bigger councils often prescribing times, maybe every six months or on special holidays, which allows them to cater for larger numbers. Something that is special about our Council, I believe, is that we do our best to cater for individual needs and requests - and so we arrange small group ceremonies to suit the participants. The Mayor has the honour of conducting these ceremonies and, in the ten months since I became Mayor there have been six such ceremonies. This has given us the opportunity to welcome some 29 new citizens to our Shire. Some of them have been here a relatively short time (the minimum time is three years) and others are long term residents who have been part of our community for maybe forty or more years.

Their countries of origin are increasingly diverse. In previous times, new citizens have tended to come predominantly from a range of countries in Europe. In contrast, our new citizens over this past year have come from 13 different countries - Ireland, USA, India, Philippines, Mauritius, China, UK, Taiwan, Kenya, Brazil, South Africa, Fiji and Wales. All age groups are represented, from senior citizens to babes in arms.

The ceremonies therefore tend to be very personal - the more so when groups of friends or family come to share in the celebrations. Photographs are taken to capture the memories and it is always a warm and happy occasion. The mixture of cultures and talents they bring with them not only adds to our diversity but also to the richness of our communities and our lives.

We welcome them with open arms and hope they take every opportunity to become involved in their local community and that they will be proud to call Australia home.

I thought I would share with you the words of the pledge of commitment made by our new citizens:

*As an Australian citizen  
I affirm my loyalty to Australia and its people  
Whose democratic beliefs I share,  
Whose rights and liberties I respect  
And whose laws I uphold and obey.*

These words also form part of our Australia Day celebrations where we join together in saying these words as an affirmation of our commitment to this country.

## Councillor Comment by Cr Cris Ruhr

## Open air burning amnesty- Residential Areas

Working in conjunction with the CFA and the Municipal Fire Prevention Committee, Murrindindi Shire Council will allow an '**AMNESTY PERIOD**' for burning off in all residential areas, in preparation for the upcoming 2014- 15 fire season.

From **1 October 2014 to midnight 14 October 2014**, residents/ landowners will be allowed to 'burn off' any vegetation material on their properties without obtaining a permit.

Fires must be no larger than one meter in diameter or one meter in height.

Residents burning off need to ensure that smoke from their fires do not cause a nuisance to neighbouring properties.
