## COMMUNITY LENDS A HELPING HAND

Community members, Murrindindi Shire Council staff and Nexus Primary Health have celebrated the 'International Day of People with Disability' by building prosthetic hands for amputee landmine victims throughout the developing world.

The gathering of over 30 participants worked in small groups to assemble a set of pre-packaged parts into a light-weight and simple, yet fully functional, prosthetic hand that attaches to a residual limb. The participants were given the added challenge of working with their dominant hand covered to inhibit its use.

The prosthetic hands will now be delivered to end-users in third-world countries at zero cost to the recipient.

Facilitated by staff from Campaspe Shire Council, the workshop was a unique opportunity for the group of volunteers to be involved in a worthwhile cause and giving them a chance to work with and get to

know Council employees. . Council's Community Services Portfolio holder Councillor John Kennedy was there to experience the day and found it very rewarding. "What we learned about amputee victims across the world was extraordi-

nary. There are approximately 300,000 landmine-related amputees in the third world today, and 20% of those are children. The people impacted are usually unable to afford a working prosthesis and the cheapest option costs about \$3,000," said Cr Kennedy.

Helping Hands is a philanthropic project founded by the Ellen Meadows Foundation and globally, the company has distributed 12,000 hands to date. Since the Australian Branch was started in 2012, over 1500 hands have been constructed with a goal of 5,000 by the end of 2015.

"In just over an hour and a half, we constructed eight hands to be donated to people in need – that's such a small amount of time to spend changing somebody's life for the better", said Cr Kennedy. Following the hand building workshop, participants then heard from a number of local guest speakers including members of Dame Pattie Menzies

Centre in Alexandra who live with a disability, some of whom also work with people with a disability.

They spoke of the challenges and accomplishments they have experienced in both their personal and professional lives, and highlighted the importance of improving the community's awareness and understanding of disability.

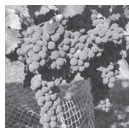

# MAYOR'S CHAIR

## COUNCILLOR MARGARET RAE

In today's world of technology, we often hear warnings about scams, hacking, cyber attack and so forth. And very often, apart from the fact that half the time we're not really sure what they are talking about, we tend to feel that it's something that happens 'out there' and has nothing to do with us.

It only takes a few short minutes to realise that is not true, and so I thought I would share a recent experience that happened at the Council's head office with you.

What we experienced was what is called a 'malware' attack. Now some of you will recognise the term, but for those who don't, 'malware' is short for 'malicious software'. It is designed to encrypt files – that is, to convert data or information into a code especially to prevent access, thus making it impossible for the files to be opened by the user.

In this particular instance a Council officer innocently opened an attachment on an email from what appeared to be a NSW Government department. It turned out that it was, in fact, from a Russian syndicate and, moreover, these attacks are designed not only to incapacitate computer systems – they are actually attempted black-mail, as the syndicate then follows up its malware attack with an email demanding money in exchange for 'unlocking' the files.

I am pleased to be able to tell you that this attack was detected rapidly, the problem isolated and the potential damage reversed. Like most large organisations, Council maintains a range of security protections and monitoring systems designed to fight off such attacks, but these are not always able to catch new malware. Luckily, Council's Information Technology Unit was able to identify the issue promptly, isolate the affected computer and halt the encryption process without loss of any critical information or electronic records.

There was no breach of privacy and information contained in Council's new information management system remained untouched. But there is much to be learned from this for all of us. The benefit of having good virus and malware protection software which is regularly updated is invaluable, as is the practice of regularly backing up the data and storing the backup somewhere else. But this discipline should not let us drop our guard and we should all remain alert to increasingly sophisticated attempts to part us from our money.

Many of us will have received phone calls from supposed technicians purporting to be from reputable companies who try to convince us they can fix a problem on our computer – which we didn't even know existed. Nor does it – unless we actually give them access. Then the trouble starts.

If you don't recognise an incoming email, if the caller is unknown to you, or if something simply doesn't feel quite right, trust your instincts and trash the email or hang up quickly. Any legitimate agency will contact you in an open and accountable way.

So, the good news is, no harm done – and a real time test of our systems.

# COUNCILLOR COMMENT CR CHRISTINE CHALLEN CATHEDRAL WARD

*"No female no uncertificated bankrupt or insolvent no person attainted of treason or convicted of felony or perjury or any infamous crime no person of unsound mind and no person not qualified as herein required shall be capable of being or continuing a member of the council of any borough."* Municipal Institutions Amendment Act, 1863.

What an illustrious fraternity of colourful characters to whom women were legally assigned!

This Clause remained in the Statutes until its repeal in November 1914. The same year Australian soldiers marched off to The Great War.

2014 is the centenary of women being allowed to nominate for local government. The Australian Local Government Women's Association celebrated this milestone last month with a book launch of "The right to vote; the right to stand." It's an insightful collection of historical facts and anecdotes, and highlights some wonderful, feisty females who rebelled against a stuffy, colonial establishment. It also lists every woman who has served on Victorian Councils, pre and post amalgamations. The author is Helen Harris OAM, Councillor at the City of Whitehorse.

After Victoria became a separate colony (from NSW) in 1851, it passed legislation in 1854 enabling local councils to be established. The first of these municipalities were Collingwood, Prahran, Richmond and St Kilda. The Towns of Melbourne and Geelong had already been proclaimed. Although the 1854 Act limited the vote to property owning adult males, women did appear on the voter rolls, confirming that in law, references using the male pronoun also applied to females and so it was that in September 1863 Acts were passed relating to local government confirming that property owning women could vote in council elections, however **not** if they were married. In common law, which overruled the Municipal Electoral Act, "a married woman's status was so entirely merged with that of her husband that she became incapable of exercising almost all public functions."

Following many legal challenges and downright disobedience, Edmund Cotter, member for Richmond, saw the light and put forward a proposition which led to a Bill passing the Assembly in 1914. The Argus newspaper reported: "The Age of Chivalry is not dead. Mr Cotter MLA has performed a feat worthy of the days of old when knights were bold. The result will be (unless the Legislative Council prevents it) that women will be eligible to sit as municipal councillors." Fortunately for us all, the Upper House approved the Bill. In 2014 the percentage of elected female councillors is 34% and for the first time in the State's history, every Victorian Council has at least one woman Councillor.

**Notice of Preparation of Amendment—Amendment C54**

The Murrindindi Shire Council has prepared Amendment C54 to the Murrindindi Planning Scheme.

The amendment affects the whole of the Murrindindi Shire Council municipal area.

The amendment proposes to revise the Murrindindi Planning Scheme Local Planning Policy Framework to reflect current strategic directions for land use and implement a more usable and relevant planning scheme format.

You may inspect the amendment, any documents that support the amendment and the explanatory report about the amendment, free of charge, at the following locations:

Submissions must be made in writing giving the submitter's name and contact address, clearly stating the grounds on which the Amendment is supported or opposed and indicating what changes (if any) the submitter wishes to make.

Name and contact details of submitters are required for Council to consider submissions and to notify such persons of the opportunity to attend Council meetings and any public hearing held to consider submissions. In accordance with the Planning and Environment Act 1987, Council must make available for inspection a copy of any submissions made.

The closing date for submissions is 30 January 2015. A submission must be sent to the Murrindindi Shire Council, PO Box 138, Alexandra, 3714.

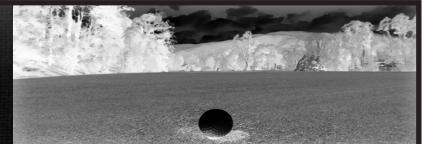
