Mindfulness comes to Marysville again in 2015

Marysville local and project coordinator, Merran Guest has been working closely with Openground -Mindfulness Training, has once again secured a Grant this time from the Marysville & Triangle Community Foundation (auspiced again by the Marysville Men's Shed) to provide Mindfulness Based Stress Reduction training to the Marysville & Triangle community. This Grant covers all costs to run the program for \$50 per person, normally costing \$700 per person; however concessions can apply to applicants.

"There is still no doubting the trauma everyone who lived, worked or visited Marysville and district felt before, during and after the 2009 bushfires," says Merran Guest. "Although it is now almost 6 years since the day of the bushfires, the deep seated trauma experienced by many is still apparent. Many people have found it enormously difficult to recover, not only from the practical losses such as property, but also the psychological effects of the fires. Many are still finding it difficult to function on a day to day basis with unhelpful thoughts and difficulty with sleep and personal interactions."

The long term objective of the project is that people who participate will have better skills to think clearly, less reactively and function at a higher level than previously.

Originally developed by mindfulness pioneer Dr. Jon Kabat-Zinn, this 8-week course has been helping people around the world acquire the tools to manage their stress. Mindfulness is a skill that anyone can develop and we now know that mindfulness training literally re-sculpts your brain. More than three decades of research has found that the majority of people who complete the 8-week MBSR course experience:

lasting decreases in physical symptoms like hypertension, heart disease and chronic pain

major improvement in anxiety, stress, PTSD, depression, sleep disturbances, relationships and addictive behaviours

enhancement in learning ability, concentration, creativity, resilience and emotional intelligence.

This second course in Mindfulness-Based Stress Reduction begins 3rd February, 2015. Tuesday classes are running in the evening in Marysville at the Community Centre. It is suggested that you apply early via as the course was fully attended in 2014.

Application process: Any adult who has experienced the trauma of the 2009 bushfires and its aftermath, or stress as a result of the bushfires, who lived or currently lives in the Marysville and surrounding district, is encouraged to apply via <http://openground.com.au/marysville.html> There is a \$50 pp charge (negotiable) to participate with the rest funded by the MTCF.

About Openground: Openground engages with individuals and organisations to promote the practice of mindfulness as a transformational process in health, education, industry and community development.

About the facilitator: Nik Welsh is the National Coordinator of Openground and also facilitates the MBSR course in Ringwood. She is a qualified addiction counsellor, where her work includes mindfulness-based relapse prevention. She meditates every day and takes part in a week-long silent meditation retreat every year. Nik lives in the Yarra Valley with her husband and their three children.

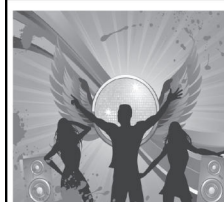

SAFETY ON THE WATER THIS SUMMER

As Summer gets into full swing on Lake Eildon, safety becomes a primary concern. As all boaties should know, the rules of the road, when it comes to alcohol consumption, apply to the water as well. You could be breathalised on the water and if you are in charge of a vessel and found to be under the influence, there are significant penalties.

Safety equipment is mandatory and you should ensure that your vessel complies with the law for the safe enjoyment of your family. Don't ruin your holiday time or that of anyone else by not being a responsible boat owner.

Our ambulance service, as always, is there to assist should an accident happen and our land based service is augmented by the "CFA Emergency Vessel", based on Lake Eildon which can quickly reach areas inaccessible to land vehicles. At this time of the year, extra Paramedics supported by local volunteer Ambulance Community Officers are on call at Eildon.

The Alexandra District Ambulance Support auxiliary supports our Paramedics & local ACOs and has provided extra equipment that is housed on the CFA Emergency Vessel.

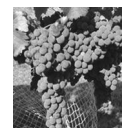

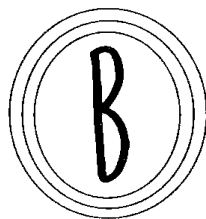

Council's Chief Executive Margaret Abbey said it was most impressive that Rob managed to ride so far in such a short space of time.

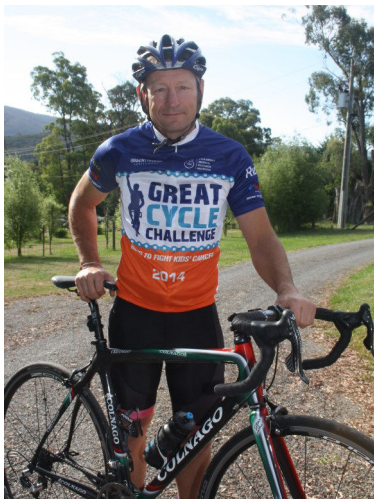

Campfire safety “falling on deaf ears”

Authorities are shocked at the number of fires found on a day of Total Fire Ban earlier this week.

The Department of Environment and Primary Industries (DEPI) District Manager Goulburn, Lucas Russell, said campfire safety messages are falling on deaf ears.

“On Monday rangers patrolled campsites in State forest, National Park and Reserves around Mansfield and came across around 45 campfires on a declared Total Fire Ban day, six of which were unattended,” Mr Russell said.

“Many forest fires in our district are caused by people, and every year our firefighters are called out to fires started as a result of ignorance, stupidity and irresponsible behaviour.

“DEPI, Parks Victoria and Victoria Police are trying to reduce the incidence of these fires through increasing public awareness and by boosting compliance operations in the region.

“With extreme heat predicted for Friday (2 January) and Saturday (3 January), co-ordinated compliance activities will continue throughout the holiday period across the entire Hume Region.

“Authorised officers from these agencies have a regulatory responsibility to enforce the laws that reduce the risk of bushfires on public land and help protect communities from reckless and irresponsible behaviour. All fire offences will be taken seriously.”

Mr Russell said there are thousands upon thousands of campers in and around the Murray and Goulburn rivers at this time of the year, with unattended campfires also an ongoing problem.

“The volume of visitors in these high risk areas is of most concern,” Mr Russell said.

“Campers need to be proactive and seek information while they are having fun camping. Being away from home and in remote areas is not an excuse for ignorance. Campers must make the effort to know the fire danger ratings, check for Total Fire Bans and ensure they know how to safely construct and light a campfire.

“Campfires are not allowed on a day of Total Fire Ban and must be attended by an adult at all times when going.

“Campfires must be put out before leaving the area using water, not soil, as fires can still smoulder under soil. If a fire is cool to touch, it is safe to leave.

“It only takes one unattended campfire to go bush and it can quickly endanger lives, livelihood and property.”

Under the *Forest Act 1958*, the maximum penalty for leaving an unattended fire is \$14,761.

Information about Fire Danger Ratings and Total Fire Ban declarations is available on the CFA website at www.cfa.vic.gov.au or by calling the Victorian Bushfire Information Line on 1800 240 667.

If you see anyone behaving suspiciously or ignorantly, call 136 186 and report it, or contact your local DEPI or Parks Victoria office, or police station.
