## AN UPDATE ON EVIE....

Everyone is aware by now that Kate & Michael Gleeson's daughter Evie was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukaemia on the 15th December.

There is a facebook page set up for Evie that has regular updates on it, but for those of you who aren't on facebook I will aim to put regular updates in the Triangle news for you.

Evie has been in the Royal Children's Hospital receiving chemotherapy since she was diagnosed. She was able to leave on the 29th December, but unfortunately she was only out for 2 nights and had to go back in due to an infection. Since then she has been kicking butt and was again discharged on Thursday 15th January, and so far everything is going well. Kate, Michael, Max & Evie have a townhouse they are staying in which is located 10 minutes from the hospital, so it's great that they can all be together and out of the hospital.

Today (Tuesday 20th January), Evie went back to the hospital to get her results, to see whether the chemo is working and this is the results in Kate's own words - So at this moment Evie has no leukaemia cells which is good news, however her neutrophils count is not yet high enough to start next block of chemo tomorrow which is called consolidation phase, she will have another finger prick Thursday to hopefully tell us she is right to start Friday with lumbar puncture and chemo in spine, then some chemo we will learn to give to her at home 4 days a week through an injection in her tummy via insuflon. All very full on and confusing and we still haven't quite got our heads around it!

But we are hoping there will be a few times we can get back up to Marysville home a couple of days a week. Looks like at least 2 visits per week to RCH with all going WELL till march 19th which will be the end of consolidation.

Kate, Michael, Max and Evie are very homesick and miss Marysville so much.

Hopefully they will be home soon. Also, they are very appreciative of everyone who is donating money and for everyone's messages of support.

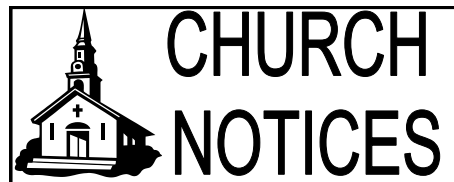

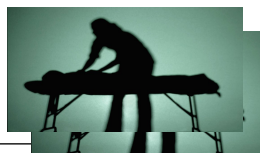

We have fabulous local produce including wine, olive oil, honey, fudge, home made preserves, soaps, and gorgeous baked goods as well as great coffee on offer.

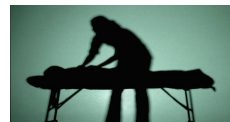

### Fox control

**Lake Eildon National Park, Rubicon State forest, Big River State forest, Cathedral Range State Park, Marysville State forest, Yarra Ranges National Park and Toolang State forest**

The Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning (DELWP) and Parks Victoria are committed to protecting and enhancing the natural values of parks, reserves and state forests across the state. Examples of this conservation management are the control of introduced plant and animal species which can impact on these values.

As part of an ongoing strategy, the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning is laying baited baits containing sodium fluoroacetate (1080 poison) on public land for the control of foxes. Baiting commenced **Monday, 19 January 2015** and will continue until **Friday, 18 December 2015**.

Baits have been laid at strategic sites and other known areas of fox habitat within the above mentioned forests and parks, and within the vicinity of townships: Eildon, Rubicon, Taggerty, Buxton, Marysville, Narbethong, Healesville, Warburton and Toolang.

1080 poison signs have been posted throughout the baited areas and members of the public who are living, visiting or working in the above named areas are advised to take particular care not to disturb or interfere with bait stations. Domestic dogs and cats are particularly susceptible to 1080 poison and should be under effective control, muzzled or kept away from the poisoned areas.

# **BUXTON'S MULTIPLYING RABBIT POPULATION**

The bobbing white tail of a retreating rabbit gladdens the heart of a child and many adults as this sight is witness to a living environment, and a rabbit taken singularly can be a cute animal.

However, the history of the rabbit in Australia, the burrows and ankle turning scratchings and the nipped off flowers, shrubs and vegetables – not to mention the digging of burrows under sheds and houses, does little to endear the rabbit to us in general.

A rise in the rabbit population can also induce a rise in other ferals – the fox and the cat, and they will snatch convenient prey from our diminished native fauna at every opportunity. It is therefore worthwhile suppressing a proliferation in rabbit numbers if possible – suppression being preferable to an eradication program.

The Buxton Progress Association, being representative of all Buxton residents and property owners, encourage and request that all of us take steps to minimise the breeding of wild rabbits by reducing nesting habitat and opportunity and ripping burrows and perhaps allowing your dogs to do their bit as well.

Our local Environment Officer has brought to our attention a website – [www.feralscan.org.au/rabbitscan](http://www.feralscan.org.au/rabbitscan) which allows you to record sightings of rabbits in our location - which is 37° 25' 0" S, 145° 43' 0" E.

A "sighting" is the number seen on a particular visit to a chosen area – not each and every single casual sighting. Over time and with input from a cross section of the residents, a picture can emerge which will show the extent to which rabbits have inhabited the area and whether an eradication program is justified. It would be best if a number of residents chose a common short period in which to "count" the rabbits and record them. A picture may emerge and if warranted a baiting or other program can be financed through a grant - available from somewhere, I am not certain from whom. Blackberry clearing can be included in an eradication program as this weed provides breeding habitat and we can get good advice and maybe assistance from our local blackberry control group.

Clearing entanglements of weeds, shrubs and blackberries and blocking off access to under floor spaces and checking woodpiles for hiding spaces can all help to subdue the rabbit population.

**So the appeal is for all residents and landholders in and around the township of Buxton to be aware of the increasing number of rabbits and please take steps to reduce breeding sites to help keep numbers down.**

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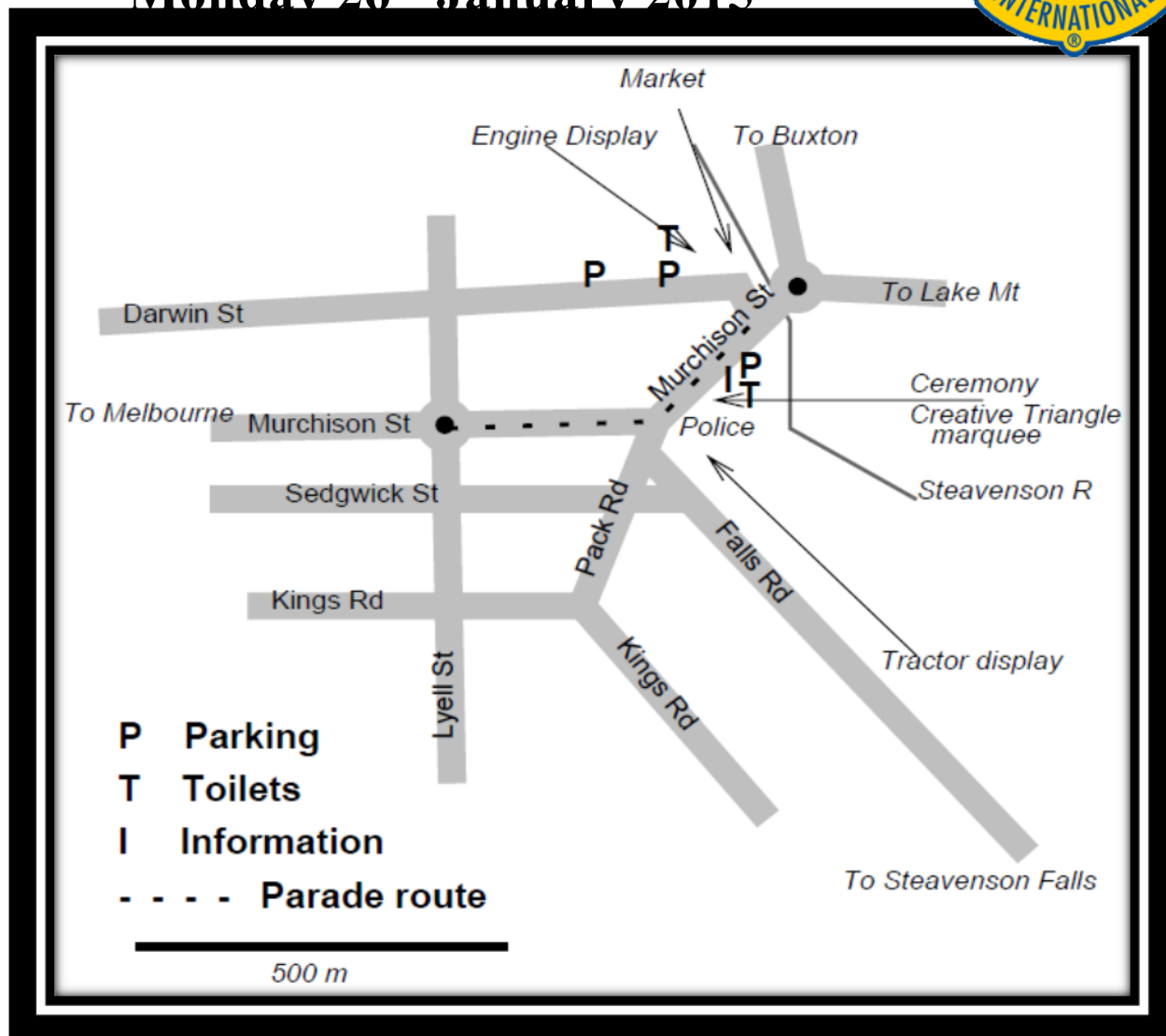
