Mayor's Chair Cr Margaret Rae

Later this week we will come together to commemorate the centenary of Anzac Day - a very significant time in Australian history. For those of us who originated from elsewhere and who did not grow up with the Anzac legend, this is an aspect of Australia and its culture that is very important to learn about and understand.

I well recall not long after my arrival in Melbourne, standing and watching the Anzac Parade move slowly past. The parade included buses full of war veterans and, seeing their faces at the windows, I couldn't help but wonder what it all really meant to them. My learning was just beginning; theirs was coming to an end. That was many years ago and they are no longer with us. But they have been joined by many more from more recent wars. Sadly, whatever our individual backgrounds, we all share the experience of war in one form or other and we have not yet moved to a level of human development that will enable us to resolve our problems without physical conflict.

Over recent years though, a number of things have evolved which we can only hope will take us in the right direction. The resurgence of interest in history - particularly family and military history, combined with access to an amazing amount of data and records now available online - means that we can get a picture of how our forebears contributed to creating and maintaining their world for the future of their families. We also get a glimpse into the cost, the pain and the sacrifice that accompanied this. The younger generations, with a better understanding of what the previous generations did, now join the parades and march with pride and respect. These are our leaders of the future and they will be able to bring their enhanced understanding to their decision making in the future. In the meantime communities all over Australia will gather on Anzac Day to recognise and honour the contributions made by so many, not only then but in subsequent wars as well. For Anzac Day is the day on which we remember Australians who served and died in all wars, conflicts, and peacekeeping operations. Here in Murrindindi, there will be a number of ceremonies: the dawn ceremonies, which commemorate the Gallipoli landing, will be held at Alexandra, Glenburn, Kinglake and Thornton, and there will also be a number of other ceremonies across the morning. Please check the advertised times and locations carefully and I hope you find one you will be able to attend.

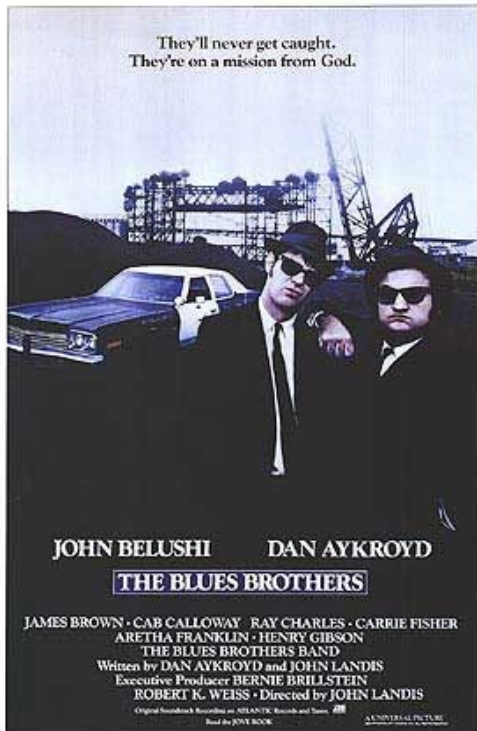

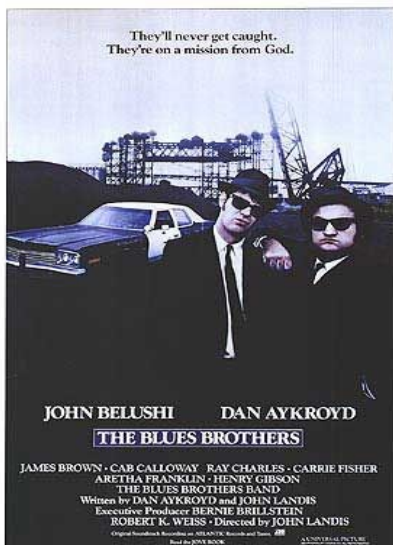
