

Local SES Support Successful Search For Missing 14 Year Old Boy



On Monday afternoon 14 year old William Callaghan became separated from his family while bushwalking at Mt. Disappointment, near Whittlesea. The alarm was quickly raised and search teams from Victoria Police and SES near the area responded, searching through the night for the lost boy. By Tuesday morning the search had increased in size, with more Police, SES, CFA, Bush Search and Rescue, DELWP, Ambulance Victoria and other emergency services responding in force. In addition, hundreds of spontaneous volunteers from the public came to offer assistance, searching by 4WD, motorbike and on foot; and even providing firewood to keep searchers warm at base camp.

Media interest in the event grew quickly, with extensive coverage by television news programs,

newspapers and social media outlets gaining the attention of the public across Victoria and the country. With temperatures dropping to zero over Monday and Tuesday nights, concern was growing rapidly for the health of the missing boy.

On Tuesday afternoon, Marysville SES volunteers received a request to deploy and assist at the search early the next morning. A crew of four answered the call, preparing supplies, equipment and vehicles on Tuesday night in preparation for the early start.

"Four of our members departed Marysville at 6am to be on scene for an 8am briefing" reported SES Unit Controller Josephine Hunter. "We were tasked to line search an area of bush between the summit walk and staging area, not far from where William went

missing. The vegetation was thick with fire regrowth and fallen trees, and searchers were often on their hands and knees checking wombat holes or tree hollows that he may have climbed into for warmth".

"As people will know from the media, one of the challenges searchers faced at this incident was adapting our techniques in response to advice from the missing boy's parents. William is non-verbal and may have been frightened by loud noises or groups of people.

Normally, we expect a missing person to respond to our calls, searchers or the helicopter, but in this case, Police had to think more strategically about how we should search" continued Ms. Hunter.

Just before lunchtime, search crews received word that William had been located.

Back at base camp, SES members used large marquee walls to improvise a safe and quiet area for William to be reunited with his family. After he had been safely transported to hospital for observation, spontaneous applause broke out among the searchers, many of who had spent three days looking for the boy.

"The moment we knew William was safe was a great one for our team and reinforced how important the work we do is. Every little bit helps at a search. Our local crew are highly

experienced in operating in remote and difficult terrain, and we were pleased to be able to provide our skills to support our colleagues from the Central SES Region".

If this event has inspired you to find out more about how you could help in a search like this, now is a great time to become an SES Search and Rescue member.

For these types of responses, you don't even need to live locally – the Marysville SES includes members from Melbourne areas who are keen to help with non-time critical response to search events. Marysville SES will soon be commencing a basic crew

member training cycle, so now is a great time to join – email marysville@ses.vic.gov.au, check out their Facebook page, or phone Unit Controller Josephine Hunter on 0409 180 653.

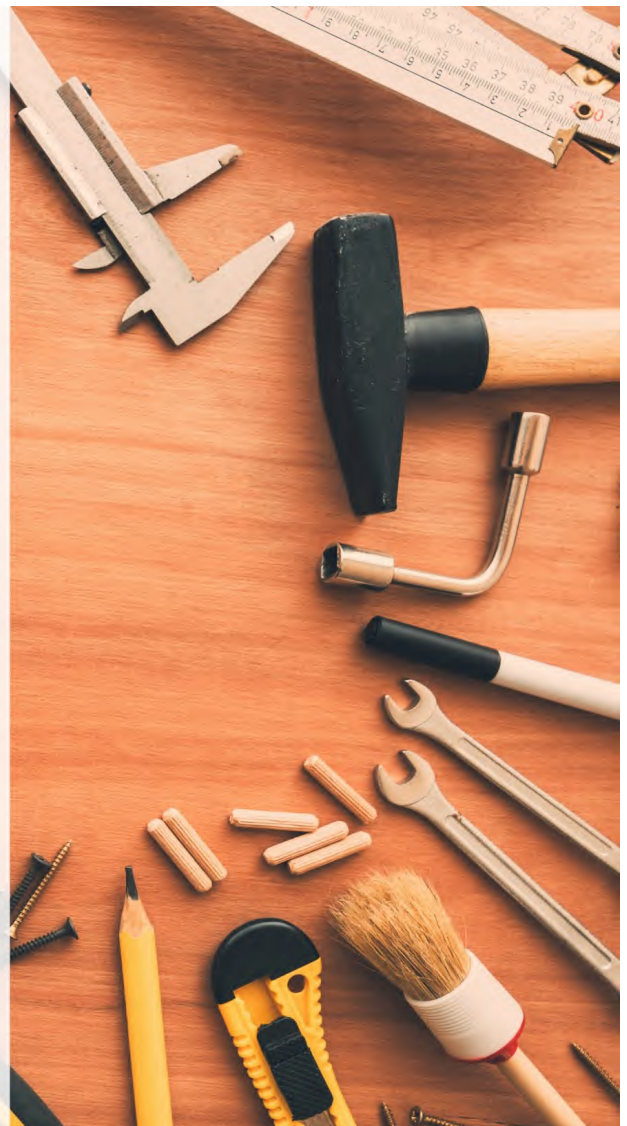

Chilly Winter Days No Match For 'Backyard Bird Count' Enthusiasts

You don't need to be an expert twitcher to take part in the 'Backyard Bird Count' - all you need is a spare 20 minutes, a nice hot cuppa and some winter woolies.

Many Murrindindi Shire residents would be familiar with BirdLife Australia's annual 'Aussie Backyard Bird Count' which is held each October. However, there are seasonal surveys that run all year round. And you guessed it, it's time to take part in the Winter survey!

Murrindindi Shire Council's Environment, Library Services and Information Technology Portfolio Councillor, Rebecca Bowles, said the Backyard Bird Count is a great way for the community to connect with the natural environment and a fun way to help gather valuable data on the birds we share our environment with.

'It's easy to get involved. All you need to do is go outside for 20 minutes and count how many birds you see and what type they are.

You'll need to download the 'Birdata' app and take your smartphone or tablet outside with you to record all the birds you see at your place.



If you need help identifying any of the birds you see, you can take a look on the 'Birds in Backyards' website under the 'Bird Finder' section or you can download the free Aussie Bird Count app.

'The results from the Winter Survey will tell us how our birds are faring by generating data about different bird species and their abundance in certain areas, their breeding activity and different interactions they may have with other birds', said Cr Bowles.

'If you see anything out of the ordinary or worth mentioning you can also add some notes to your survey.

Maybe some birds were feeding on the native plants in your garden? Or maybe you noticed a

few different species interacting with each other?

Any extra information you can provide is helpful. It may not mean much to you, but experts can understand different types of bird behavior and recognise whether it's normal or unusual.

'If you usually take part in the annual 'Aussie Backyard Bird Count' then why not get involved in the seasonal surveys too?

By combining data from different surveys across the year, it increases the availability of data which helps decision making when it comes to environmental policy at local, state and national level.

It can also be used as a tool to promote conservation action for particular species of birds.

'Council, together with Plastic Free July will be supporting residents with resources to help them make positive changes - especially at home.

Plastic is everywhere in our homes and is a genuinely useful material, but so often we use it once and throw it away.

With many of us working from home and staying home on weekends, we've seen a rise in home baking - and everyone seems to be planting veggie gardens! These activities can help us to reduce our consumption of plastic.



'Council wants our community to get behind the Plastic Free July campaign to take on the challenge of plastic waste reduction.

The focus for Plastic Free July this year is on things all of us can easily change around the house including how we shop, what we cook and the types of products we use in the home.

Personally, I plan to use recycled mesh produce bags and refuse to buy any fruit or vegetables wrapped in plastic. Even though I'm an avid recycler, it distresses me how much plastic I seem to accumulate in my bin that I can't recycle.

GOVERNMENT FUNDED FLU VACCINES ARE NOW AVAILABLE AT THE MARYSVILLE MEDICAL CLINIC

These are free vaccines for the following people:

- Aged 65 and over
- Children between 6 months and 5 years
- Pregnant Women
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people aged over 6 months
- People aged under 65 with an increased risk due to medical conditions such as cardiac disease, respiratory illnesses, severe asthma, diabetes, and immune compromise.

Unfortunately we currently do not have any private flu vaccines for those who do not qualify for a government funded vaccine.

Patients must make an appointment for a flu vaccine. No walk-ins.

We ask that people are patient as we try to administer flu vaccines as quickly as possible whilst maintaining the required social distancing measures.

We are also experiencing some delays in receiving stocks of flu vaccines and ask for understanding if you have to wait until new stock is available.

The purpose of the online meeting is for community members to tell us about the impacts of COVID-19 and how Council can best support community recovery.

Council's Community Planning Portfolio Councillor Sandice McAulay said she wanted to hear directly from individuals and community groups to get a better understanding of what our community needs and what's going to be important in both the short term and long term.

'Recently we've run similar online meetings for business owners and event organisers in our Shire, but next week's session is about the community as a whole.

We want to understand the impact of COVID-19 on your life, your family, your work and your community groups. We want to hear about the positive experiences you may have had, and we also want to hear about the challenges you have faced during the pandemic.

Maybe you've got a great story to share about a community initiative borne during the pandemic that you would like to see continue? Or maybe you can tell us what you found challenging over the past few

months and where more support is needed? We want to understand how our community is faring.

'We want Council to play a big role in helping our community recover from the effects of the pandemic. So we are working with health and community service providers to develop a COVID-19 Community Transition Plan. That Plan will be built with the input and ideas gathered from the community groups and individuals during the online discussion.

We want to develop a plan that focuses on the strengths of our community and how we can support communities within Murrindindi Shire to adapt, evolve and thrive', said Cr McAulay.

'The Plan will help guide us in the delivery of a number of initiatives to support relief and recovery activities. We hope it will also empower community members and groups to drive positive change themselves.

'We want to make sure this is a

living plan and that the ideas the community puts forward are backed with resources and timeframes for implementation.

To this end, we will incorporate the actions identified in the Plan within Council's Municipal Public Health and Wellbeing Year 4 implementation plan.



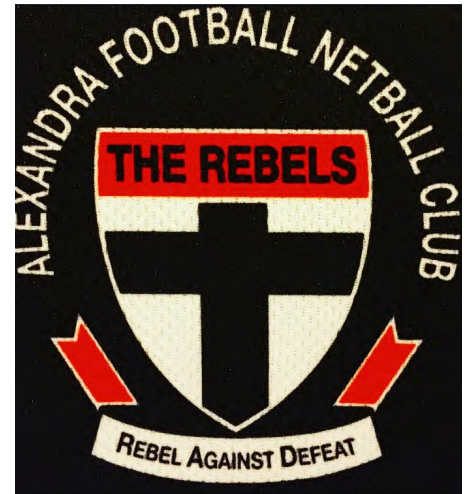

Earlier today, the AFL Goulburn Murray has advised the Clubs that the 2020 regular season will be cancelled due to Covid-19 concerns.

Some Clubs indicated during discussions that there was an appetite for some practice games later in the year and the AFL Goulburn Murray encourages this if it suits the Club and is safe to do so as it would give the kids some football and netball in 2020.
