

Phone.- 7.15 p.m., 14th July, 1918.

From Major General Rosenthal:—

" We hold Junction of Boche trenches, U.5.d. - S. of ^{Courps} your boundary.

" We are holding that junction. - We are occupying SYRIA Trench

" from there ^{eastward} up to where the road ^{through} in MONUMENT WOOD cuts our

" boundary in 6.c. (about 500 yds.). - The E. end ^{of Syria Trenches} is very shallow

" and we can't occupy it. - We have posts just beyond the road,

" up to as far as 6.central.- We are joining back from 6.central, -

" through U.6.b. to the ^{old} Boche system ^{now our system} at the railway line ^{at} 0.36.d.

" (about) 5.0.

" We have 2 prisoners. - ~~They~~ ^{We} are still fighting at the S.W. corner

" in 5.d. - General WISDOM is making a connection across NO MAN'S

" LAND from the junction of trenches in ⁵ 5.d. towards our inter-

" national post. - He will consolidate on the line ^{you} you have given

" ^{you} me tonight. "
