(2) Refugee employment and training

January Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) 1983.
show: Australian born unemployed at 9.8%
Polish 17.6%

in reality Refugee would have much ~~larger~~ higher unemployment rate & can be as high as 54.3%
probably the unemployment of refugee to be around 30%

CES → in 23 offices — survey show
Polish 1161 registrants out of 22,000 (22,776) 5.3%
Cypriot/Greek — 4106
Italians — 3461 out of 102,000 people

At St.ilda CES Polish registrants are the largest group 200
or 12.6% of total registrants at St.ilda (1588 people)

In Melbourne Poles make up 1% of total migrants but
in CES offices Poles averaged 5.3% of migrant
unemployed! over
