CIRCUIT NEWS & NOTES

Conference has approved the uniting of the Golden Square and Quarry Hill Circuits and so from January 1st., 1967 we will be part of the new Circuit to be known as Golden Square - Quarry Hill.

Early in January the Reverend Elson B. Cousins will take up residence in the new Circuit assuming pastoral responsibility for Kangaroo Flat, Specimen Hill and Lockwood. The central pastorate will be Golden Square and Quarry Hill churches with Rev. E.B. Gamble as Superintendent and Rev. Fred Savage having oversight of Kennington, Strathfieldsay and Mandurang. We anticipate something of a team Ministry enabling us to be more effective in our service.

While various proposals and offers for housing have come before us we are still looking for a final choice. Naturally we must watch costs as furnishings, etc. will also be involved. We want to avoid temporary plans so we are anxious to settle on something permanent or for at least a year.

At our last Quarterly Meeting proposals were made regarding united Sunday evening services, but as this is a Leaders' Meeting decision which each Leaders' Meeting must individually consider, Conference has made it impossible to reach a decision in time for this plan; however, some combined services will be fitted in.
