

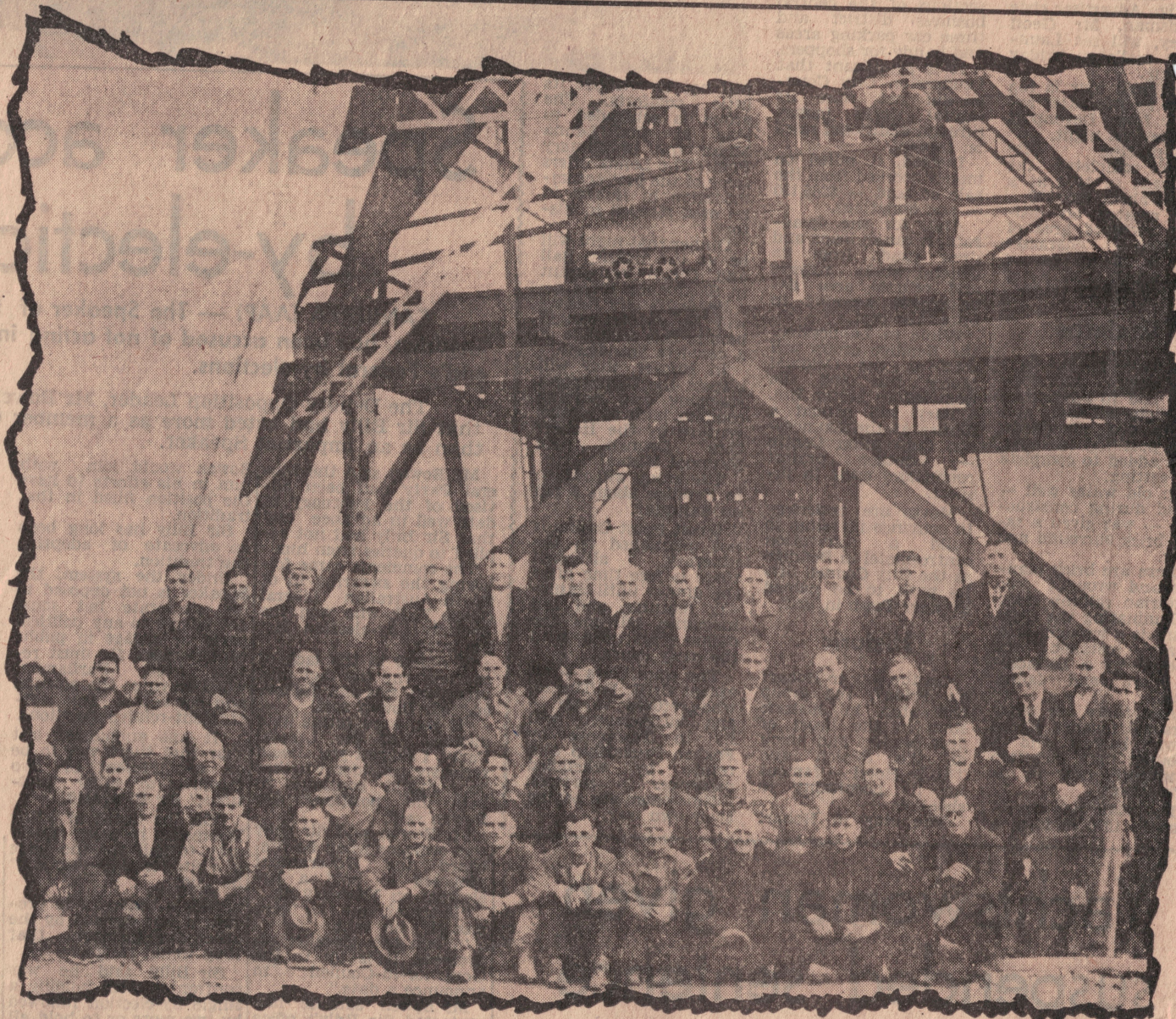
Old chums identified
