If aggrieved by any matters included in or omitted from any rate other than in respect of the assessment of the value of the rateable property any person may, within two months after notice of the assessment of payable by him is given, give notice in writing to the council of his intention to appeal to the County Court in the manner set out in Section 304 of the Local Government Act as amended by Section 7 of the Valuation of Land (Appeals) Act 1965.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government cts payment is hereby demanded from you of a rate as shown on the reverse side of this notice - of the Latt annual valuation, due and payable on the 10th day of December, 1967 of the property of which you are the owner or occupier.
