In 1980 following the death of Mrs Amy
Dunstall, a public meeting appointed a
committee to raise funds for a memorial.

On 22nd November 1981 a seat was
presented to the City and this is now
in the Conservatory gardens.

Since then the very time consuming
job of researching Amy's articles in the
Bendigo advertiser, more particularly over
the last 10 years of her life, was
undertaken. We are indeed grateful
to Mrs Sylvia Hampson who did this
work on an entirely voluntary basis.

Then came the matter of the
microfilming of the articles which
had to be done in Melbourne and we
thank Mrs Beverly Porteous for her
help in this matter & we also
thank the staff of Shalvake Public Library
in Melbourne for their willing co-operation
with the firm who carried out this work.

The films are now being indexed
as part of our gift to this library.

It is very pleasing to the Amy
Huxtable Memorial Committee that
these microfilms, an original for
permanent record and a copy for general
use, should be the first gift to
the 'North Central Goldfields Library on
its move to this magnificent new home.
