THE PREACHING PLAN

Once every quarter the ministers of Bendigo and Eaglehawk meet to arrange the preaching plan.

This is always a difficult task, since there are 36 appointments to be filled each Sunday, of which the ministers can take only 18. Without the loyal sacrificial service of our Local Preachers, Methodism in Bendigo could not function in its present form.

It is at this point however, that the ministers are concerned that some of our Local Preachers (particularly the older ones) are being over worked.

This problem is accentuated in the present quarter, since so many of our preachers and ministers are absent on holidays in January, and it is an almost impossible task to fill the plan.

Having considered the matter carefully, and bearing in mind the fact that many of our church people are also absent in January, the ministers unanimously recommend that combined services be held in each circuit during the month of January each year.

If this recommendation is acceptable to the quarterly meetings it will be implemented in January 1964.
