

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT FOR 2006

The highlight of 2006 has been the progress made in the planning for our innovative new school which should be fully operational in 2010. The college master planning committee which includes staff, parents and students has made a lot of progress in developing the plans in a very short period of time. We are all excited about what is being developed and believe that our students will all be winners from this bold initiative.

Academically our students have performed at very high levels. Our top students have continued to get outstanding results at statewide and national competitions in Mathematics and English. Last week it was pleasing to see so many of our ex students achieving outstanding results in the VCE. James McEwan was just pipped as the Dux of BSSC, and other students received the top individual results in English, Maths and ICT. I was also pleased to see one of our ex students win a Premier's Award in VCAL. We are just as proud of the fact that last year almost 10% of our exiting Year 10 students are going into either an apprenticeship or a pre apprenticeship next year.

During 2006 we developed a new partnership with Access Employment and Peppergreen Farm that resulted in 12 of our Year 10 students completing Certificate 2 programs in Building and Construction or Horticulture one day per week. This program has been very successful and has made a huge difference in the lives of the students involved. We plan to continue in this partnership in 2007.

In the Arts, our students have continued to shine. Anyone who attended the music concerts each year cannot help to notice the tremendous improvements that our music students have made in their time at Weeroona. The artistic talent in our college extends to the Visual Arts and Multi Media. At the Combined Schools Art Show in November we once again saw the high quality of work our students produced on display.

In all of the interschool sporting arenas our students continued to represent us with distinction. Of special note was the success of our Year 7 students who made it through to the state finals in cricket, football, netball and to the regional finals in basketball. This year we continued to develop our relationships with the Sandhurst Weeroona Cricket Club and the YMCA Harriers. This is all part of our commitment to promoting community sporting links to try and involve more students in sport.

One of the sporting highlights of the year was our contacts that we had as a college with the Scottish Commonwealth Games team. Some of our students received coaching from these elite athletes in Athletics and Squash. The two young hurdlers who spoke at our Term 1 assembly won lots of fans.

Our college also took a leading role in successfully organising its 5th Annual Interschool Gymkhana although it is hard to believe that our first attempt was rained out in the middle of the worst drought for a century. On the second attempt it was very successful. We continued our incredibly successful participation in the Energy Breakthrough Program under the leadership of John Taylor and Brendan Stewart. In October we had three teams compete in a demonstration event in front of 20,000 spectators at the end of the Herald Sun Tour in Carlton.

During 2006 Esmae Barnes stepped in as our new Council President and Sue Clarke replaced Gay Huggard as the President of the Parents Club. On behalf of the college I would like to thank all of the members of Council for giving up your time to support the college this year. I would also like to thank the members of Parents Club and any other parents who volunteered their time to help in our college.

At the end of October 2006 our Business Manager, Rod Chapman retired after 19 years of excellent service to this college. Glenda Elliott has also retired after 13 years. I would like to wish them a long, healthy and happy retirement. I wish to thank these staff for all of their many contributions to the college and wish them well for the future.

Finally I would like to thank all staff for their continued support and hard work in 2006. To all the students leaving Weeroona College I wish you well for the future and trust that you will all go away with positive memories of our College.


