"ORSOVA" takes her name from a small Danube town on the Rumanian side of the frontier with Yugoslavia.

Below Orsova is a series of rapids which for centuries made that part of the river almost unnavigable and thereby earned the name of the "Eisen Thor" or "Iron Gate." It was with these rapids in mind that Mr. Lynton Lamb, F.S.I.A., designed her badge in the form of a Penstock or watergate.

With "ORSOVA," Mr. Brian O'Rorke, A.R.A., F.R.I.B.A., has been responsible for the interior decoration of his fifth successive Orient Liner. His association with the Company began with "ORION" in 1935.
