

# Bendigo Synagogue

1853 280 Jews in Bendigo

Situation - Allotments 2 & 3 Section 16  
now known as Hobson St  
Grant 10/5/1858 RS 2924 & 391

1853 First services in tent - S. Moses & J. P. Joseph officiated

First services 1854 for High Holidays  
at 'Cape of Good Hope Stores' kept by Mr Helbrun  
(These stores near the present side bgd Advertiser)  
Bendigo Jews sought financial assistance  
of the Melb Jews for erection of Synagogue  
but unsuccessful

1856 Sandhurst Hebrew Synagogue  
consecrated for divine worship

This was a wooden building and no  
photo survives as far as known

1858 Rev J. Friedman appointed minister  
and carried on for 10 years.

The New Synagogue was erected in 1871  
and consecrated in 1872 by Rev J. Stone.  
It was a square building <sup>35' square</sup> and the neat  
effect produced, by the free use of white  
bricks. It was built in the Byzantine style  
It had thin square turrets on each corner  
rising from the base to about 20 feet above  
the roof - A large octagonal lantern tower  
rises from the centre of the roof.  
each turret and <sup>the</sup> lantern were surmounted  
with the 'Shield of David'

The fittings were a gift of Morris  
Samuel in 1875 at the cost of nearly ££300-00

The building was erected by Vahland  
& Getzschmann & cost a little over £2000

+ held 200 on the ground floor + nearly 100  
in the gallery. The Rev J. Myers is the Minister.  
Another report (Bgo Advertiser 30/9/77) says  
the Synagogue was built for £1300 + would  
hold 500.

The consecration Service was as follows  
~~(See)~~ from Bgo Advertiser 30/9/1872

The Officers of the Synagogue bearing the  
Torahs to the door saying.

"Open unto us the Gates of Righteousness.  
We will enter therein + Praise the Lord.  
This is the Lord's gate the righteous  
shall enter therein. The doors opened  
& on entering said "How beautiful are  
Thy tents oh Israel - O. Lord - I love  
The Habitation of Thy House and the  
dwelling place of Thy Glory. We will enter  
into Thy Sanctuary & worship at Thy  
Footstool. The procession having advanced  
the reader repeated these words. -

Blessed He who cometh in the name of the  
Lord - We bless you from the House of  
the Lord. The procession headed by the  
Minister & each carrying a Torah  
chanting psalms walked at around  
the Synagogue 7 times.

Suitable prayers were then  
offered - The Queen + Royal Family  
and other the scrolls were deposited  
in the Ark.

The last minister to officiate was  
Rabbi Joseph Goldstein who died in 1902

In 1925 a Fascom Service was  
held at the Synagogue attended by  
members of the Jewish community in Boro  
& former members who travelled  
from Hellgate.

The building was demolished  
between Nov 1926 & Jan 1927 and the  
fittings dispersed - some of the  
seats are in the Masonic Hall in  
Udo St Bendigo.

Unfortunately all the Trustees are  
dead and all <sup>the</sup> records - there been  
unable to discover. Perhaps one day  
they will turn up in some attic.

The building was sold for between  
£800 - £900 and deposited with  
Cohen & Kirby solicitors in Bendigo.  
The interest to be used for any  
Jew in distress or pay for a funeral.  
I understand that only once was  
there a call for a small amount  
and about £50 in conjunction to  
with Dr P. Goodman, myself and  
the Soleacter Mr Bush decided that  
(the money) as it had been dormant for so  
many years it would do a lot more  
good if given to The Montepiore Home.  
This was arranged by the Soleacter  
& thus closed the epoch of the Bendigo  
Synagogue.

then Rev. <sup>Dr.</sup> Goldstein for a short time, <sup>1880 - 1883</sup> 1883-1904

then Rev. Bernstein ~~left early~~, 1904?

then to Murray.

but evidently carried on for the fortys  
with existing bima for a few years  
then finish.
