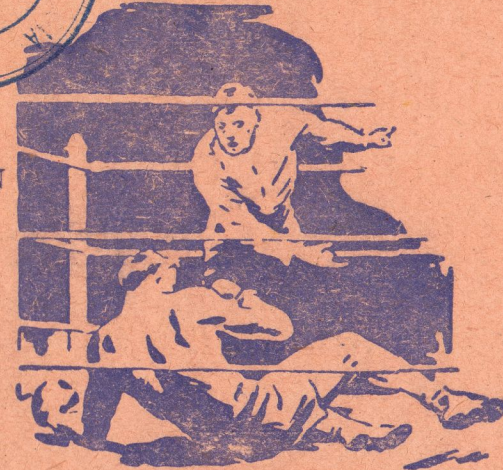

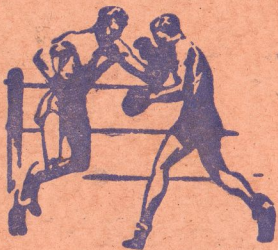

AWARDING OF POINTS (Boxing)

Points are awarded for direct clean hits with the knuckle part of the closed glove of either hand on any part of the front or sides of the head or body above the belt, and for defence (the successful avoiding of blows, so that the attack of the opponent misses). Swings are considered correct if they land as described above. Hits on the arms do not count. Back-hand blows are not allowed. Points are given for attack and tactics. Foul blows are not counted. If the Referee warns one of the competitors for a foul, the Judges and Referee award points to the other competitor.
