The monthly meen of the benewas presided over by Mr. W. Wright yesterday. In his monthly report, the acting-superintendent (Mr. teridge) stated that there were 145 inmales in the institution, patients had been admitted, discharged, and eight had died. tributions totalling 578 had been made to families in destitute circumstances at a cost of £87, including £9/16/6 for food supplied to families residing in distant parts. The cost of the supplies was as follows:-Tea, £10/10/1; sugar, £15/9/3; beef, £15/11/6; flour, £9/0/3; bread, £14/0/8; meal, £4/ 40/; rice, £3/2/2; and sago, £4/10/3; making a total of £77/5/.

Mr. E. G. Ham, scoretary of the Bendigo Easter Fair Society, notified that the annual meeting of the society woud be held to-morrow night. period would terminate the term of the board's representatives (Messrs, W. Wright and A. J. Hamilton), but both were eligible for re-election. It was unanimously decided that the two retiring representatives be re ppointed. with Mr. J. P. Christie as a substitute

representative.

The treasurer (Mr. G. Mackay) reported that payments during the mont i unounted to £619/8/7, and the present debit balance was £5322/18/6. which could be greatly reduced it ceraln promises were fulfilled.
