

HINDE Richard David

Richard David Hinde was the son of William Hinde and Mary Ann Windram. He was born in Lancashire England c. 1837. His father William was a stonemason.

Richard arrived in Victoria c. 1857. He married Sarah Cole in 1865 in White Hills Bendigo. Marriage File)1387.

Sarah was born in Somerset 7th March 1847 and baptised in the Parish Church North Pemberton Somerset 14th March 1847. Her parents were Robert and Elizabeth Cole. Sarah deceased 17th September 1928 - buried Baptist Section St. Kilda Cemetery.

Occupation of Richard Hinde was Publican and Brewer.

Richard Hinde died age 41 years Accidental Death Scalding 7th August 1878

Sarah became Publican after Richard's death.

Sarah used to visit Charles and Ellen Reynolds with Bel at Burwood Road Hawthorn and Charles and Amelia at Lingwell Road Hawthorn.

HINDE Robert Kingsley

Robert Kingsley Hinde possibly eldest child of William and Mary Ann Hinde nee Windram.
Born Lancashire England c.1835.

Married Isobel (surname unk.) Born c. 1827. Robert and Isobel separated and both did not remarry. There were no children.

Robert Hinde had an orchard on the Campaspie River which he willed to his sister Eleanor.
At some stage lived at Bagshot on the Loden River near Bendigo. He died circa 1925.
