Married Theresa Helen Gifford (Tessie) at St. Paul's Bendigo C of E. 1894

M/F 6568 - 1894 - Tessie born 1875

Children - 1895 Raymond Gifford B/F 1061

1897 Thelma Hinde B/F 1056

1902 Norval Noel B/F 8081

1914 Sydney 9th November

1918 Maxwell Harvey (Jim)

Harry Thomas named after friends in White Hills called Tom and Harriet.

Amelia visited Maitland Avenue Kew when Jim was crawling.

Looking for death of Harry Thos. The following appears the only suitable entry.

Reynolds - Harry Thomas - decd. 1955 Preston age 83 D/F 14108

Father unknown - Mother unknown Helen

Tessie's father fatally shot himself accidentally getting through a fence while rabbiting. Ref. Amelia.

Birth - Helen Teresa Gifford - Father Charles - Mother Helen Ma.McLennon born COGH 1875 B/F 1311 Coghills Creek Vic 3364.

Legend - There was a story that Harry Thomas remarried after death of Tessi e and had two other children..

There is a marriage of a Harry Thomas Reynolds 1923 M/F 12148 to a

Maud Gardner Barker.

(Could be Barnes not Barker)

Haven't yet found death of Tessie - Could be under Helen Reynolds or Theresa Reynolds.

Ref. Amelia could be 12th Dec. 1922.

Mother of Harry Thomas was Eleanor - could be spoken as Ellen and his wife's name was Helen as was also her mother named Helen.

Possibly death informant does not know the family information.

Raymond Gifford -1st W/W soldier - remained in UK after war and married

Thelma Hinde married and died without children

Norval Noel - Believe married with 5 children

Sydney - Believe married with 5 children

Maxwell (Jim) decd. Batchelor.

Maud Hutton Gardner F. James M. Emma Porter born EAGL 1872 B/F 8584 could have married Harry Thomas and also could have been the mother of Dolly known as Dolly Barnes. Dolly Barnes was the infant reared by Ellen and Chas.Reynolds for four years until reclaimed by Gardner/Barnes. C. 1911. It would appear that Ms Gardner/Gardiner was a single mother and that the father of the child was a Mr. Barnes - possibly married. Ms. Gardiner took 4 year old Dolly and it was said went to live with Barnes. On one public record the name in the marriage was unreadable and later in another it appears as Barker.

Ms. Gardiner In 1923 age 51 is unlikely to produce two more children. However the name Dolly is unlikely to be the child's proper name.
