




To cater for travellers three hotels were opened in the Longlea area. They were the Homebush which was run by Mr. Benjamin Code: the Perserverance which was owned by B. O. Dobinsky and the Acott also known as the Axedale Hotel. This was burnt down about 1909. It was rebuilt and later shifted to Axedale. Many shanties popped up throughout the district. The Perserverance Hotel was run by a Mrs. Hunt. This also was pulled down in 1909 and shifted to J. Browne's property at Axedale to be used for sheds.

KERR'S HOTEL

Mandurang was on one of the main roads in the early days. It was well used by travellers because it avoided the steep incline of Big Hill, and also avoided toll dues. Along this road Mr. Wm. Keating built the first hotel in 1858. In 1860 it was purchased by Mr John Hargreaves, but passed to Sam Snowden, thence to Oigetti and finally to Mr. Wm. Kerr.

William Kerr rebuilt the Hotel on the main road opposite the present Tennis Courts and carried on the business until it closed.

The Wine Hall, previously known as the Junction Hotel, was first occupied by Mr. O'Marah in the fiftees. Olgetti who leased it to Lodding, was the next owner but during his term the licence was lost, the building, having a flagstone roof, was deemed unsafe for public use. A wine licence was secured by Olgetti who in turn passed it over to Michael Frawley. After a further occupation by a man named Marchesi, it passed on to Bernado Togno who eventually lost the wine licence. A stone bearing the date 1877, when the present structure was erected, may be seen in front. Opposite Togno's was Smith's Shanty, a very conspicuous place as the name suggests.
