Grace and Health. Whereas you have represented unto us that you are resolved to enter into the holy state of Matrimony, and are desirous that your Marriage may be proceeded with in the face of the Church, according to the Rites of the Church of England, but without publication of Banns: Now, therefore, being willing that these your honest desires may the more speedily obtain due effect, We do, by virtue of our authority as Archbishop and ordinary Pastor of this Diocese, grant our License and Faculty for the solemnization of such Marriage, as well to you, the parties who are desirous of contracting, as to the Officiating Minister in the ~~*Parish or~~ *District of *Eastorne* who is designed to solemnize the same, in the manner and form above specified: **Provided** always that there shall appear no impediment, by reason either of kindred within the prohibited degrees, or of any Precontract of Marriage, or of any suit commenced in any Ecclesiastical Court, or of any other lawful cause, to bar or hinder the proceeding of the said Marriage, according to the tenor of this License; and that the provisions of the "Marriage and Matrimonial Causes Statute 1864" be in all things complied with; and provided, also, that the same be had and done publicly in the *Church or ~~*Licensed Place of Worship or~~ *of St Pauls* in the ~~*Parish or~~ *District of *Eastorne* aforesaid, within Three Calendar Months from the date hereof.

Given under the seal of the See of Melbourne, which in this behalf is used, this *19th* day of *March* in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and *twenty three*. and in the *2nd* year of our Consecration.
