Minutes:- Previous Meeting Minutes read & Accepted.

Moved M.Mansfield Seconded R.Sach Carried.

Matters Arising from those Minutes:-

1. Query in regard to future financing of VCVC.

Explanation that the final decision would need to come from the VAVA.

2. A cheque of \$40 was received from the VAVA to establish initial VCVC funds.
3. Advice from Ararat that their Association is no longer in operation.
4. Advice of Westernport Association & their proposed initial Competition.

General Business:-

1. Discussion of future Country Tournaments.

Final decisions made as per below.

Future Country Tournaments will be in the form of a complete Round Robin system with Finals, to the extent that time permits.

Moved R.Stanton Seconded J.Dewar Carried.

Plans of future Country Tournaments are to be presented at VCVC Meetings 2 Months prior to the staging of such Tournaments, or if no Meeting is held close to this time limit then the plans are to be forwarded to the VCVC Executive for approval.

Moved M.Mansfield Seconded T.Stevens Carried.

Referees will be allocated to matches at these Tournaments by the VCVC.

Mens & Womens matches at Tournaments will be staggered.

i.e. Each Associations Mens & Womens Teams will not be drawn to play at similar times.

Trophies for each Tournament will be the responsibility of each host Association. Geelong Association are to be advised of their debts for Tournament fees during 1974 and if payment is not forthcoming they will not be permitted to compete in future Country Tournaments.

Moved W.Gollong Seconded A.Lowe Carried.

2. VAVA Player affiliation fees.

From Jan. 1975 VAVA Player affiliation fees will be paid to the VAVA through the VCVC. Seniors \$2 Juniors \$1

Juniors in Country Victoria are to be regarded as those players under the age of 18 years as at the 1st Jan. each year.

Moved M.Mansfield Seconded R.Sach Carried.

Complete lists of registered players with the appropriate fees are to be submitted to the VCVC from each Association by the 30th June each year, & these lists are to be updated by the 30th Sep. in the same year.

Moved M.Mansfield Seconded R.Stanton Carried.

Suitable player registration forms will be forwarded to each Association.

A cheque account in the name of the VCVC is to be opened by the Treasurer & from Jan. 1975 Association affiliation fees will be paid to the VCVC. \$20 / year

Moved T.Stevens Seconded J.Basten Carried.

3. Co-operative buying.

Details of equipment prices are to be obtained from a Warrnambool firm, these details are to be presented at the next Meeting for comparison with prices to be obtained by dealings with the VAVA.

Moved R.Stanton Seconded R.Sach Carried.

Other Business.

W.Gollong is to enquire of the Westernport Association if they wish to be administered by the VAVA or the VCVC. Their geographical location is such that it may be necessary for them to come under the control of the VAVA.

A report of the running of the 1974 Country Championships at Morwell was forwarded to the VAVA. W.Gollong made mention of the salient points contained in this draft to the Meeting.

A draft of the Victorian Referees Association Constitution was given to the VCVC delegates for examination. Suggested alterations are to be put forward at the next VCVC Meeting.

The V.R.A. failed to form a Committee at their last Meeting, however, a further attempt is to be made, probably in 1975.

A long term proposal for the VCVC is the formation of a Victorian Country Referees Association.

The possibility of the staging of a Victorian Country Championship for Juniors is to be discussed at the next VCVC Meeting.

W.Gollong gave advice to the Meeting of a Metropolitan High Schools Volleyball Competition during 1975.

Volleyball films very few in Australia, VAVA has one but this is quite old. Some video tapes can be made available for a suitable fee through the VAVA.
