MATTERS ARISING

- 1.Warrnambool confirmed as the venue for the 1976 Country Championships.
- 2.Meeting advised that Echuca has applied to join the VCVC and Shepparton has declined at this stage.

GENERAL BUSINESS.

- 1.Echuca's application for affiliation with the VCVC was tabled and after discussion M.MANSFIELD. moved that The Echuca & District YMCA Volleyball Association be admitted as a member association of the VCVC and that the secretary advise them accordingly.

- 2.After much discussion on the subject D.WATSON. moved that each association provide the secretary with the names of two delegates who would be prepared to represent the VCVC at VAVA meetings.
From these delegates a roster be drawn up of which association would represent the VCVC at each VAVA meeting. He also moved that consideration be given to those associations furthurest from Melbourne to ensure that they were not called upon more than once a year.

- 3.The position re VCVC meetings was discussed and it was decided that the position would remain as at present and VAVA be advised that they will be invited to each meeting.
- 4.VAVA'S request for the proposed draft of our constitution & by-laws was discussed.It was decided that it be left to the secretary to advise VAVA that when a draft of the above has been fully prepared they will be forwarded a copy and that we will not be rushed into preparing a haphazard constitution which may cause us problems at a later date.

5. M. MANSFIELD. moved that the 1975 update for the second half of the year be abandoned and that in future all updates are to be done as soon as each association commences a new competition.

6. M. MANSFIELD. moved that in light of the increased expenses involved in running the Country Championships and the fact that all registration moneys collected by the VCVC are passed to VAVA, VAVA be requested to subsidize this and all future championships with the sum of \$250:00.
