Minutes of Last Meeting

Minutes of last meeting were read by the Secretary K. Brooks moved that the minutes be accepted as read.

Matters Arising from minutes of last meeting

1. The position regarding Echuca's position was discussed and at the moment it appears doubtful that they will continue with their application to join the V.C.V.C.
2. All names of delegates to represent their associations at V.A.V.A. meetings have been reviewed.
3. V.A.V.A. provided the \$250.00 subsidy for the Country Championships as requested.

General Business.

1. After discussion it was decided that in future the entry form for the Country Championships be amended to read total entry fee \$50.00
2. After discussion it was agreed that the \$250.00 requested from V.A.V.A. this year was not a set amount but that it would be reviewed each year.
3. Regarding the re runs of the Asian VolleyBall Championships Murray Mansfield advised that the A.B.C. had decided to give Volleyball a rest for a while. It was suggested that all associations write to the A.B.C. and request re-runs.

4. Murray Mansfield moved that all moneys received as entry fees for the Country Championships be paid to the host association

An amendment as follows was moved by Q. LOWE: That all money's collected from entry fees and the V.A.V.A. subsidy be paid to the host association who will be responsible for settling accounts etc.

5. It was explained to the meeting that it was up to the discretion of the host association as to whether or not they awarded individual trophies for best players, runners up etc -.
6. R. KENTER moved that the host association be responsible for draws for the country Championships and that the draws be forwarded to the V.C.V.C. for approval prior to distribution

7. Approval was granted for the Ballarat Association to conduct their next tournament on the 11th and 12th of September.
8. The date for the annual meeting of the V.C.V.C. was also set as 11/9/76.
9. Albury-Wodonga's verbal application to join the V.C.V.C. was discussed and it was advised that they could no longer join due to pressures being applied to them by the NSW Volleyball Association.
10. After some discussion it was moved that the Secretary write to the Mt. Gambier Volleyball Association C/- YMCA Mt. Gambier giving details of conditions of entry to the V.C.V.C. and asking them regarding their present intentions.
11. The position regarding V.C.V.C. registration was discussed. M. Mansfield advised that a total of 1539 players were currently registered and this represented a drop of about 30 on last years total.
12. Approval for 1 Swan Hill girl and 1 Geelong man to play in the Championships although they were not registered was confirmed.
13. The position regarding a constitution was discussed and it was decided that the Secretary write to Mr. F. Stevens and invite him to prepare a draft copy.
14. The position regarding the future of V.C.V.C. Country Championships was discussed and several proposals were put forward. It was decided that the Championships would continue to run as at present. If more Associations joined the V.C.V.C. the position would be looked at again.
15. M. MANSFIELD moved that
1. He be paid personal expenses of \$9.40 for postage of registration forms etc -
 2. That the Bendigo Institute of Technology be paid \$8.00 for computer paper used.

16. D. WATSON moved that \$50.00 petty cash be forwarded to the Secretary.

17. M. MANSFIELD moved that players to be eligible to compete in the Country Championships must fulfil the following conditions.

- (a) Be registered with the V.C.V.C.
- (b) Play regular competition in his/her associations current season.
- (c) Reside, work or study etc- outside the Metropolitan area.
- (d) In Special cases the V.C.V.C. be able to give approval to any player to participate in the Country Championships.

18. The decision to allow Swan Hill to compete in these Championships with only five players was confirmed.

19. M. MANSFIELD moved that the 1977 Country Championships be held in Geelong and that the V.C.V.C. approve Geelong's proposal to conduct an Under A Championship in conjunction with the country championships.
