SUGGESTIONS FOR FUNCTIONS OF COUNTRY VOLLEYBALL COUNCIL

It was disappointing to receive only two official replies to the initial circular of the Interim Committee. Associations who are the greater distance from the Metropolitan area, and therefore the ones to gain the most from the formation of the C.V.C., were noticeably absent in their responses. If these Associations expect that all the work should be done for them, they can expect no better treatment than they may have received in the past.

You are therefore urged to consider the agenda and the following suggestions seriously, to enable each representative to participate actively in this Inaugural meeting.

Suggestions are as follows:-

1. Preparing and programming a Volleyball Calendar.
2. Coaching and Refereeing clinics.
- 09 3. Exhibition matches of State teams
4. Selecting venue, date and stipulating rules, for the Victorian Country Volleyball Championships, by say November of each year prior to the event.
5. Organizing venues and dates for invitation tournaments between Country Associations. (Deadlines as in 4 above for example)
6. Act as a distribution centre for VAVA correspondence, news, etc, concerning Country Associations.
7. Recommend potential State players to the VAVA.
8. Co-operative insurance of volleyball players in Country Victoria.
9. Co-operative purchase and distribution of Volleyball equipment.
10. Co-operation with VAVA in all other matters, for the betterment of Volleyball as a whole.

COUNTRY VOLLEYBALL COUNCIL FORMATION

Dear Sir/Madam,

This letter is to advise your Association of a forthcoming meeting of Country Association Delegates, to be held at Warrnambool during their tournament, on the 17th and 13th August, 1974.

The express purpose of the meeting will be the formation of a Country Volleyball Council, and the election of a small Executive Committee to spearhead the Council. Your Association is asked to elect a Delegate to serve as a Council member, and for he/she to attend this meeting, even if your Association does not intend competing in the Tournament.

An interim committee of three members were elected at the recent Country Championships, held in Morwell. On that committee's behalf it is requested that your Association submit your comments on the functions of the Council as you would like to see them. For example, Running Country Championships, Coaching, Referee's assistance, Co-operative supply of Volleyball Equipment, etc. It should be emphasized that the functioning of the Council must fit neatly into the overall structure of Volleyball administration in Victoria, and not cut across the functions of bodies such as the Referees Board for example.

Please forward this list of proposed functions to the above address before the 31st July, to enable the interim committee to prepare and distribute a suitable agenda for the meeting.
