

INTERNATIONAL COACHES COURSE: ADELAIDE..MAY 1976:

At the A.V.F.Inc. executive meeting held in Melbourne on 25th Oct. the S.A.V.A.Inc. put forward a proposal for its conducting of an ASIAN ZONE..International Coaches Course. The application by the S.A.V.A.Inc. was sanctioned by the A.V.F.Inc.

Whilst exact dates are at the moment subject to confirmation, the following information is pertinent to would-be-applicants for the course:

Venue: Adelaide S.A.

Dates: May 1976.

Costs: \$50.00 (Aust) course fee plus accomodation and meals.

Duration of Course: Approximately 10-12 days.

Mr. H. Baacke, Chairman, Council of Coaches, F.I.V.B. has advised that the Commission of Coaches, F.I.V.B. have recommended that a course be arranged in Australian in 1976.

PREPARATORY INFORMATION REQUIRED:

Of main consideration to the S.A.V.A.Inc. and the A.V.F.Inc. is the to conduct the course in Australia, a MINIMUM OF 20 AUSTRALIAN PARTICIPANTS are required:

At the executive meeting of the A.V.F.Inc. on 25th October it was resolved that all State Constituent Associations be promulgated that an International Coaches Course would be held in Adelaide in May 1976 and that would-be applicants provisionally apply for the course in order that it may be determined if 20 or more coaches would be interested in participating on the International Course. Information to hand gives the impression that at least 20 Australians would be interested in participation on such a course. However, at this stage, applications are called for for nominations and upon receipt of same, determinations as to the viability of conducting the course will be decided.

If, as hoped, applications received give credance to conducting the course, applicants will be included on the mailing list to be drawn up and they will receive an Official Application Form at a later date.

Applications are therefore called for from would-be applicants for the International Coaches Course, Adelaide, May 1976.
