At our recent meeting of the V.C.V.C. expressed their gratitude and congratulations to the V.A.V.A. for the successful staging of the FIRST ASIAN VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS in Victoria and specifically for the three matches played in the country centres.

Your foresight in accepting the responsibility to stage this tournament was commendable and did much to promote and more often introduce the game to the general public.

Your acceptance of the proposed to stage three matches in country areas was greatly appreciated and even though this may have caused the Organizing Committee extra problems you can be assured that the benefit derived was beyond all expectations.

There is no doubt that Victoria is the leading state in Australian Volleyball and the Country Council was pleased to be able to contribute through it affiliates, in some small way.

Would you please offer our congratulations to the committee and we fully appreciate the amount of behind the scenes work they must have done to make the championships the success they were.

At our meeting we also discusses the proposition of appointing a State Volleyball coach in 1976. The opinion of the delegates present was that it would be more beneficial to appoint an experienced overseas coach to coach at higher skills levels than just beginners basics. It was felt that the responsibility of introducing the sport to school children and beginners lies firmly with the local established associations, and to ask an experienced top line coach to spend time at this level would be unrealistic.
