VICTORIAN COUNTRY VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Replying to item No.10 of your last letter addressed to the Victorian Amateur Volleyball Association, I wish to advise that the proposal by the V.C.V.C. that V.A.V.A. subsidize this year's as well as all future V.C.V.C. Country Championships to the amount of \$250.00 has been discussed at the last V.A.V.A. executive meeting and has received favourable consideration. It has been decided that the Victorian Country Volleyball Council receives a subsidy of \$250.00 to offset part of the costs in staging abovenamed Championships. It is left to the discretion of the executive of the V.C.V.C. how this money will best be spent, as hall rentals and administrative costs will vary from location to location. It would however be appreciated if a budget proposal as well as a final statement of the costs after conclusion of the Championships be made available to V.A.V.A.

It is with great pleasure that I am able to present the V.C.V.C. with a cheque for the amount of \$250.00, which you will find attached to this letter.

Dear Sir,

In connection with your letter of 10/2/76 and your follow up letter of 4/3/76, I wish to advise you of the following:-

1. You have already been sent a copy of the names and addresses, telephone numbers of all V.C.V.C. executives. This list also contained the names and address & telephone numbers of all executives of all country associations. Would you please recheck your records and if you have misplaced the list of all executive committee, please advise and I will endeavour to have another printed and sent to you.
2. Due to the vast distances involved it is not possible to appoint two permanent delegates to V.A.V.A. meetings, however we are at present drawing up a roster of delegates - two from each country association to attend V.A.V.A. meetings in turn and a copy of this roster will be forwarded to you when it is finalized.
3. V.C.V.C. meetings are held 4 times each year. The first is held on the Labour day long weekend at the Warrnambool Annual Seaside Tournament. The second is held on the Queens Birthday weekend in June at the Venue of the Country Championships. The third is held at the Ballarat Tournament which is held each year in late September or early October. The final meeting is held at the Latrobe Valley Tournament in early December. You will be advised of the time and date of each meeting, shortly prior to the meeting.
4. a) I am unable to provide firm dates for the Grand final of each country association as not all associations have started competitions, some are currently playing finals, and others have started competitions, but have not yet finalised final dates. When I have received replies from all Associations and a clear picture can be obtained, I will advise you of the dates of all finals.
b) The V.C.V.C. country championships are held on the Queens Birthday long weekend each year. This year they will be conducted by the Warrnambool Volleyball Association.
c) All other tournaments with the exception of the Warrnambool Tournament in March, are not held on fixed dates.
5. You have been forwarded copies of minutes of V.C.V.C. meetings for September and December and copies of the latest meeting will be forwarded shortly.
6. At our meeting conducted on 6/3/76 I was instructed to advise you that the proposed draft of our constitution and by-laws has not yet been completed, and that we will not be rushed into completing a haphazard and badly conceived constitution only to experience problems such as V.A.V.A. did with theirs. You will be forwarded a copy as soon as the work is completed.
7. I have been advised that there has been one or two changes in the V.A.V.A executive since the last executive list you sent us. Could you please forward your latest executive update to this Council.
8. If you have them, would you please forward copies of the F.I.V.B. Congress report of the 1974 year, and copies of the Asian Championship Review.

9. On 7/11/75 I requested copies of the A.V.F. constitution from you, but to date I have received neither the copies of them, or a reply. Would you please advise me regarding this matter as soon as possible.
10. The V.C.V.C. Country Championships will be held again this year and as in past years the expenses of conducting the championships have continued to rise. The main factor causing expense is court hire over three days, which amounts to many hundred of dollars. As the Championships are conducted under the Auspices of the V.C.V.C. we feel that an individual association should not have to take the brunt of the financial burden involved, and as all registration moneys collected by the V.C.V.C. are forwarded to V.A.V.A. we request that V.A.V.A. subsidize this and all future V.C.V.C. country championships with the amount of \$250.00. Could you please forward this amount as soon as possible as the championships are less than three months away.
11. As the V.C.V.C. only meets once every three months and due to the fact that we administer eight different associations, several hundreds of miles apart and that several requests you make have to be discussed by the Council or information must be obtained from each different association before any information you request can be provided, it is not possible to give immediate replies to much of your correspondence, so could you please show a little patience especially with tall orders such as your correspondence of 10/2/76.
