Dear Mark,

Firstly, please accept my apologies for not replying to your letter requesting a transfer of registration fees for 1976. The reasons for this are several but the main one is that I was waiting for Warrnambool to forward their listings to complete the entire V.C.V.C. update, which would have enabled me to bill all associations and eventually send you the complete amount in one cheque. The second reason is that the V.C.V.C. Treasurer has dropped out of Volleyball, even in his home town, and the finances are being handled by a combination of President, Secretary and myself. This of course is not working, and when we received Wolfgang's letter, I happened to be in Morwell ten days later, and with the President, we have sorted out what registration money has been received and a cheque should have reached you by the time you get this letter.

We have an Annual meeting coming up in September in Ballarat, and our problems with a Treasurer will be sorted out there. Last June we decided to do our updating of players lists as each competition in each centre commences. This will spread the registrations out over the whole year basically, and we should be able to forward monies to you progressively. The majority of the money should reach you between April and June each year, with further payments for the remainder of the year. In Wolfgang's letter, he mentioned instalment dates of April, June and October. These are not acceptable to the V.C.V.C. and we will not be following them. We do not have a pool of funds from which we can make installments, all we can do is pay to you the money which comes in as our Registration system dictates. Will you please ensure the V.A.V.A. Executive are completely aware of the situation.

Enclosed is the Registration listing for the Associations which have now paid, and for which you should have received the money. As the other monies come through, rest assured that it will be passed on, along with the associated listing.

I trust this explains the delay this year, and I hope we have overcome the problem for future years.
