Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of 28th April, 1977. I wish to advise, with regret, that it will not be possible for your Association to participate in the 1977, Victorian Country Volleyball Championships.

The reasons for this are two fold. Firstly the constitution of the V.C.V.C states that any Association to be eligible to compete in the Country Championships, must be an affiliated Association - all players from that Association must be registered with the V.C.V.C. Secondly this year for the first time the V.C.V.C., will be conducting Under 17 Championships as well as the Senior Championships, and due to limited court space, it would not be possible to accommodate any further teams this year.

Although your Association is not eligible to compete in the Country Championships, I will advise all member Associations of your interest in participating in Country Volleyball events and hopefully this will lead to greater participation by your Association in Country Volleyball events in this State.
