Dear Daniel, (Danny for short isn't?)

Hoping to find you fighting fit after the long weekend , because I've got some more work for you. No not really, just a few thoughts and items that crossed my mind in the last week or so.

Firstly, will you send me a copy of the minutes from the two - day VCVC meeting held in April at Mont Martre, I've already asked you at Geelong but thought to remind you again. Also will you send a copy of the minutes of any future VCVC minutes and any other relevant information to my home address please ? It means an extra stamp , but if you were to send two copies to our PO BOX LVVA, I may not get my copy until someone remembers to pass it on (seeing that I am no longer on the LVVA committee.)

Now a few items for the Agenda of our next meeting at Mont Martre on Oct 1 and 2.

1. Draw up guide lines for the running of future Country Championships. VAVA has distributed one such document back in 1974 I think, and at the moment am trying to get hold of the LVVA copy of same. I will bring this along to the meeting and we will have to delegate this task to one of our many volunteers !!?? Included under item 1. should be something on Duty Teams for the Grand Finals eg the LVVA nominates the third place getter at the end of the round(s) to do the Finals (you use a similar set-up I believe). We cannot afford to leave this till the last day as happened at Geelong and every other C.C. before that. Melbourne referees for the senior Grand Finals should be continued as this was very successful at Geelong I thought. Also play-offs to determine 3rd,4th,5th,6th etc. should not be made official with commitments to additional duty teams eg at 8.30 am as occurred at the weekend, first of all because it is a drag for the duty team to have to front up the next day at what will invariably be a very early start, but secondly and more importantly, because it is contrary to the VCVC By-Laws under Article 2.4 . Furthermore, it virtually is a repetition of the round robin all over again. However, friendly (spelt wrongly) ^{matches} should be encouraged between these teams if time and court space permits, but no duty teams should be made to officiate at these matches unless a team is willing to volunteer of course.

So much for item 1.

2. Host Association's responsibilities at C.C.s should be defined a little better eg at Geelong there appeared to be only one person in charge of the whole show, which I think is most unfair. A tournament manager and two or three assistants would be required as a minimum at a Championship. At Geelong there were a couple of instances where I was called to organize a replacement referee for one reason or another, which I thought was Geelong's duty. Even though it is a VCVC event, the host Association are much more familiar with the local organisation etc and should not bother VCVC committee members in trivialities but only in matters concerning policy, what do you think? (VCVC committee members have their games to play, duty and often coaching responsibilities to contend with)

3. Policy regarding under 17 players in tournaments eg eligibility to play in senior matches on the same day or weekend etc.

4. Volleyball calendar of coming events and tournaments. Suggest the period covered to extend to December 1978 to coincide with the VAVA program somewhat (we should consider them at times you know).

5. Associations affiliation fees were not included in the treasurer's report for the VCVC year 1976-77. A date for these submissions should be set. If the country associations have not yet been called upon for their fees, I suggest you write each centre and ask for same as soon as possible.

That's all I've got on agenda items for the moment.
