
the Albury-Wodonga Volleyball Association wishes to affiliate with the V.C.V.C.

This Association is already affiliated with the N.S.W.V.A. and will continue this affiliation. The following proposals for dual affiliation are put forward.

1. Albury-Wodonga Volleyball Association be affiliated with the N.S.W.V.A. and the V.C.V.C.
2. All N.S.W. residents of A.W.V.A. be registered with the N.S.W.V.A.
All Victorian residents of A.W.V.A. be registered with the V.C.V.C.
3. Albury-Wodonga's representative teams be allowed to compete in Victorian country volleyball tournaments with its N.S.W. residents playing in the representative teams paying V.C.V.C. affiliation fees as well as the N.S.W.V.A. affiliation fees.
4. Any player of sufficient calibre to represent at state level must play for state of residence.

It is hoped that these proposals are acceptable and that this association may participate in as many V.C.V.C. fixtures as possible. Albury-Wodonga Volleyball Association is well established and appears to have a good future. Volleyball is played in most schools in the area and is growing. Each year our facilities are improving and this is encouraging more people to play volleyball.
