DUTIES OF FLOOR MANAGER

1. Ensure that the following equipment is ready for the start of each match.....
 - a. match ball
 - b. two whistles
 - c. scoresheet
 - d. two rotation order sheets
2. Collect scoresheets and matchball at the conclusion of the match and return them to the main office.
3. Post the results of each match on the result sheets, as they come to hand.
4. Compile and post ladders at the following times.....
Sat. 1.30 & 7.30; Sun. 1.30 & 7.30; Mon. 12.00
5. Acquaint yourself with the Tournament Conditions and Instructions to Referees attached.
6. A copy of the VCVC Constitution and By-Laws will be available in the main office.
7. Note that there is the potential, due to matches exceeding their allotted time, for a team not to be ready to play or officiate at their scheduled time. If a match cannot start at its scheduled time due to this reason, please acquaint the players and officials of that match the reason for the delay.

TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY:

All players must be registered as per the VCVC Registration listing, at the time of the Championships.

All teams will be required to complete a registration form, prior to their first game of the tournament, listing their finally selected players, substitutes, coach and manager. Players not listed will be ineligible to compete. Ineligible players taking the court will cause forfeiture of the match.

UNIFORMS:

Any players taking the court out of uniform, will not be permitted to play. Uniforms will be as nominated on team entry forms and include shirt, shorts AND SOCKS.

PLAYING RULES:

International Volleyball Rules, as published in October 1978, including amendments notified since that date, shall apply, unless over-ridden by local rules as stipulated in these conditions.

TEAMS:

Teams late for matches will be penalized as follows:

- * Set 1 forfeit, 0-15, if a team is not ready to take the court five minutes after referee has called teams onto court.
- * Match forfeit, 0-15, 0-15, 0-15, if a team is not ready to take the court ten minutes after referee has called teams onto court.

EXCEPT that referees shall not call teams onto the court until the appointed starting time, and penalties shall not apply if players were involved in an immediately prior match which exceeded the stipulated time period.

DUTY TEAMS:

When rostered for duty, each team must supply four duty members.
(2 linesmen, 1 scorer, 1 net umpire. Scoreboard operator is optional)

LATE DUTY TEAMS:

Teams late for duty will be penalized as follows:

- * Deduction of one Championship point for each duty member not present (up to a maximum of four points) when the referee calls the teams onto the court, EXCEPT as per the exception under LATE TEAMS.

CHAMPIONSHIP TABLE POINTS:

Points will be allocated as follows, to determine the order of the teams prior to the Grand Finals: WIN = 3, LOSS = 1, FORFEIT = 0.
If points are equal, percentage of game points for and against will be used to determine the placings. Teams finishing 1st and 2nd will play in the Grand Finals.

LOCAL RULE:

Immediately any ball enters the playing area from an adjacent court, play will be stopped and a replay given. Linesmen, umpires and referees may indicate such an occurrence.

ADJUDICATION PANEL:

If an adjudication panel is required, it will include four representatives of the participating teams, such that none of these four are related to the parties in dispute. The Chairman of the panel shall be elected from within the panel.

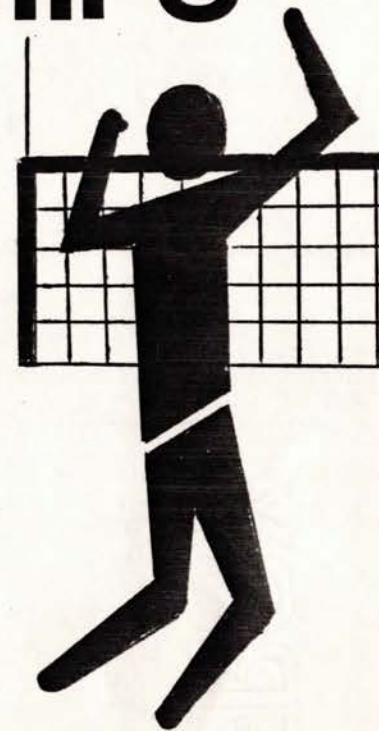
