Dear Sports Administrator.

The second Sports Administrators convention will be conducted at the Hilton Hotel in Melbourne on Friday March 7th 1980. The 1979 Convention proved a tremendous success and a great deal was achieved by all of the 260 delegates who attended.

The 1980 Convention is shaping up to be even more exciting with the probable forum of speakers involving the Prime Minister Mr Fraser, Mr Eric Ristrom, Mr R.J. Hawke and Mr Ron Casey the General Manager of H.S.V. 7. I am also negotiating with a Sports Marketing Executive from the United States to address the delegates on the preparation and marketing of Sporting events. As well I will involve all delegates in a fund raising workshop session with each workshop conducted by a proven marketing and fundraising consultant.

On Thursday the 6th March 1980 a Sports Medicine Convention will be conducted and will involve lectures on the following areas-

- 1, Musculo-Skeletal injuries resulting from Sports Stress
2. The use of Drugs in Sport
3. Nutrition and the Sportsman
4. The role of Psychology - Hypnosis in Sport
5. The role of unorthodox treatment for Sports injuries eg. Acupuncture and herbal treatment.

The objective is to familiarise people, with little knowledge of Sports Medicine, with what Sports injuries are all about, and how to treat and prevent them. Workshop sessions will be conducted.
