I am pleased to advise that at the Executive meeting of the V.A.V.A. on 3rd February 1979 it was adopted that a new schedule of player registration fees be implemented.


The schedule is set out below and we believe it should provide some financial saving to yourselves and affiliated bodies as well as being an incentive for increasing membership.

Date for determination of age classification is  
1st January 1979.

Under 15:	50 cents
Under 17:	\$1-00
Under 20:	\$2-00
Open :	\$3-00

Other requirements regarding payment of fees as set out in my letter of 10th January 1979 remain unchanged.

re: 1979 Player Registrations

As you know, player registration fees form a large percentage of the income of our Association. In 1979, they will form about 50% of our working capital. For the Association to work efficiently, and to achieve its maximum potential, as much as possible of our known income should be obtained at an early date, so that we have at hand, a readily available source of operable funds.

1978 was a frustrating year (as, I expect, were preceding years frustrating for the past Treasurer) simply because funds were not available to meet commitments as they arose. It was not until the end of the year that all moneys due came to hand, and by then the real need had passed.

To overcome a repetition of the problems of previous years, it is proposed two major changes will take place:

- a) The State Government Grant is being paid in advance - 70% of which is to hand and,
- b) Registration fees will be called upon earlier than previously.

In order to achieve b) above, it will be necessary to set a common date for which registration figures will be compiled. It is realized that Associations play their competitions at different times during the year. There appears to be four basic groups in relation to the period of competition:

1. Two competitions per year, the first commencing early in the year and finishing around mid year, the second commencing just after mid year and finishing about

about November/December.

2. Two competitions per year, one commencing about October and finishing about March/April, and the other commencing about April/May and finishing around September.
3. One competition, commencing March/April and finishing about September.
4. One competition, commencing about October and finishing about March.

It is apparent therefore, that the months of March/April will see a competition in progress in all centres, be it just commencing or near completion.

The system we propose to operate from 1st January 1979, in regard to registration fees is:


1. The date for determining age classification will be 1st January.
2. The number of players shall be determined from the competition in progress during the months of March/April.
3. Fees will remain unchanged at \$3.00 for seniors (i.e. Open and U20) and \$2.00 for Juniors (U17 and U15)
4. 50% of the fees paid in the previous year are to be paid to the V.A.V.A. Treasurer by 31st May.
5. By 31st July, the V.A.V.A. Treasurer is to receive:
  - a) Full details of Registrations for the current year broken down into males and females within each age group (Open, U20, U17 & U15) for each competition(Centre).
  - b) Payment for the balance of fees due.

We feel sure you will understand the necessity of the above changes and trust that the earlier dates will not cause inconvenience.

If you can foresee any major obstacles to this proposition, please let me have your comments as soon as possible.

Thank you in anticipation of your co-operation.
