Your request for a grant of \$250 towards the costs of staging the 1979 U17 Championships was placed before the V.A.V.A. Executive at their last meeting.

Unfortunately, no submission was ever received prior to the V.A.V.A. application for assistance to the Department of Youth Sport and Recreation in 1978, and consequently, no grant was made.

The V.A.V.A. in appointing Tomas Santamaria for a further twelve months, has found it necessary to apply very strict budgetting controls on its income, and as a result does not have any surplus money at this stage, to place towards a grant for your U17 Championships.

Following the staging of the Australian U17 Championships in Warrnambool during the May vacation, it is felt that a clearer picture of our finances may be evident, and the Executive decided to invite your Council to re-apply for the grant following the Australian U17's, if you find that the Country U17 Championships runs into a deficit.

I trust this offer is acceptable to you in light of the restrictions of our budget outlined above.
