A couple of matters for the VCVC conference.

- ① The LVVA has made a decision to support the principle of awarding the various country championships to each association in turn provided the VCVC executive has confidence in the proposed host associations ability to do the job & suitable venue.
- ② In the light of the above the LVVA would like to apply to host the 1981 Open Championships.
- ③ We have sent you earlier our attitudes re the Division 1/2 arrangements for Open Championships.

④ The U20's problem.

① With 4 courts and using Sat 9.00am - 9.00pm
 $1\frac{1}{2}$ hour time slots = 8×4 matches

Sun 8.30 - 1.00 3×4 matches ie 44 matches.

Sun 1 - 4.00 approx finals.

Entries of more than 5 teams in men & women cannot be catered for in a Round Robin.

ie $5 \times 4 = 20$ matches men + 20 women.

What is V.C.V.C attitude if we receive more than total of 10 teams (men + women) entering? At present there is no established competition grading of the associations to form Div 1 + 2. Do we perhaps split into 2 pools & play off top positions? Something for the conference to consider as we can arrange any format with 44 matches between Sat 9-9. Sun 8.3-1.00 & allowing for finals. I presume that that is a reasonable finishing time and that they wouldn't want us to use Morwell as well as Moe Stadiums.
