Dear Jenny,

Well, I seem to have got around to VCVC matters at last. Please find enclosed the refunds of bonds for the 1980 Opens. Please countersign the cheques and distribute them. Also enclosed is a cheque to Geelong transferring the Open entry fees to them. I think this is right - I don't appear to have a copy of the minutes stating that all entry fees are to be passed to the host Association, but I seem to recall such a motion, and I did it for the U17's this year. Would you please include the enclosed letter to Geelong when you send their cheque. Thanks.

A couple of points relating to the U20's. It is on the books that we invite the State Director of Coaching and/or the State coaches relating to the age group, to select the top 12 players of the tournament in Men & Women. The State U20 coaches at the moment are Mr A. Fricsons, 19 Grey Street, BALWYN. 3103, for the Women and for the Men, Mr P. Carolan, 44 Gore Street, FITZROY. 3065. I am very keen that we continue the referee grading at the U20's, so if we invited Paul Carolan, we could also ask him to act as Chief Referee. What do you think? I think we should offer some expenses for these people, certainly the Chief Referee anyway. Perhaps this could be discussed at the Conference.

I would also like an item included on the agenda for a VAVA presentation on a proposal to appoint a full time Executive Director for the VAVA. Naturally this will involve an increase in registration fees, so I would like to put on my VAVA cap, and perhaps in conjunction with another member of the VAVA, present a proposition for discussion with the delegates. As Country Volleyball is still where the strength is in Victoria, especially as regards to finance, I think they should have a major say.

As indicated at the AGM, I wish to present the following notice of motion:

## Addition to By-Laws

### 4.0 COMPLIANCE WITH INFORMATION REQUESTS

4.1 All affiliated Associations shall be required to abide by the 'Due Date' set for the return of any of the following:-

- (i) Entries for Championships
- (ii) Details of registered clubs
- (iii) Details of Executive members
- (iv) Payment of fees

4.2 At least six (6) weeks notice in writing shall be given to each Association of the request for any of the items referred to in 4.1 above.

4.3 In the case of Championship entries, any Association not returning the required forms and fees by the 'Due Date' may be excluded from the event, or alternatively, pay a late entry fee in addition to the normal entry fees.

4.4 In the case of registration and executive details, and payment of fees, any Association not complying with the 'Due Date' shall be fined.

- 4.5 The amount of any fees or fines referred to in this By-Law may be set at any General meeting.
- 4.6 Any Association required under this By-Law to pay a fee or fine, shall do so within 14 days of receiving written notice of such penalty, otherwise affiliation shall be suspended until all such fees or fines are paid.

End of Notice of Motion.

I would propose if this is passed to move that the late entry fee referred to in 4.3, be \$25 per team and the fine referred to in 4.4 be \$50. You will need to distribute this notice of motion in accordance with the Constitution before the conference.

That is about all for the time.
