There were three matters arising out of these Minutes, which I wish to draw to the attention of each Association -

(1) DIVISION 2

The V.C.V.C. would like your Association's opinion re the establishing of a Division 2 for the Country Championships and would therefore like your comments re the establishing of By-Laws, if such a Division were incorporated in the Championships.

Would your Association please submit any comments or By-Laws to the undersigned before the two day Conference in October 1980.

(2) TWO DAY CONFERENCE - 18TH & 19TH OCTOBER 1980

There will be a two day Conference held on the 18th and 19th October 1980, at the Montmarta Motel, 92 Grey Street, St Kilda.

Two delegates from each Association MUST attend. As outlined in the Minutes, a \$25 fine will be imposed per delegate not in attendance.

Would you kindly submit the names and accommodation requirements of your delegates to the undersigned, on or before the 26th September 1980.

(3) U17, U20 AND OPEN COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS

As yet there have been no venues set for the staging of the U17, U20 and Open Country Championships for 1981.

I am therefore seeking applications from Associations to stage either of the abovementioned Championships for next year.
