1. PLAYER AFFILIATION FEES - 1981
2. CLUB & PLAYER REGISTRATION DETAILS

1. Just a reminder of the new scale of fees applicable to player registrations for 1981. The scale is as follows:

Open players	\$6.00 p.a.
U20 Players	\$5.00 p.a.
U17 Players	\$4.00 p.a.
U15 Players	\$2.00 p.a.

I would urge all Associations to collect these fees from all players at the commencement of their new competitions, to alleviate the obvious problems of trying to collect them when accounts are issued later on in the year.

Normally, fees are payable in two sums - 50% of the previous years total about June/July, and the balance of the current years fees about October/November. In order to avoid serious cash-flow problems at the State level for this year only, we may be asking Associations for a higher payment about May with the balance payable about October. I will advise you in the near future of the details of this years collection.

If all of your fees are collected in advance, then a call for part payment about May should not provide any difficulties.

2. As you are aware, it is intended to produce a Victorian Volleyball Magazine this year, with sufficient copies for every member of a club, being direct posted to each club secretary. In addition to this, it is intended to produce individual membership cards, which once again, will be distributed through club secretaries.

To achieve these intentions, the V.A.V.A. will use a computerized registration system, based on the V.C.V.C. system which has been in operation for some 4-5 years now.

For Metropolitan Associations, it will be necessary to collect and provide the club name, players name and age and sex of every registered member, and the club name and name, address and phone numbers of every club secretary or representative. If this is not done, then it will be impossible to produce address labels for magazine distribution and registration cards for players.

Country Associations will only be required to update their current registration listings.

I expect to be able to forward to each Association, the necessary forms for the collection of this data sometime during March. This must be completed before the first magazine can be distributed.

The purpose of this memo is to give you prior warning of what lies ahead, to enable you to be prepared to supply the information when requested. I look forward to your co-operation in these ventures, in what promises to be a very active stage in the development of Victorian Volleyball.
