

Entries & Draw.

As per custom entries are received by VVC and a draw constructed by the host association in consultation with the VVC executive. Again this process was delayed as the VVC Secretary had problems confirming entries from some Associations. The lesser number of women's entries presented an apparent problem in how to divide the teams and provide sufficient matches. Unfortunately the October 1980 decision was overlooked and while two divisions of four were created they played a full round robin against the other 7 sides. The two divisions being maintained for finals.

After the draw & was finalized & published, Wangaratta sought to enter a women's team. This was initially refused. Subsequently Leongatha withdrew both their men's & women's teams; Latrobe Valley Veterans & Wangaratta were the replacements respectively.

The draw was organized using 4 courts, allowing 1½ hours / match with games starting at 9.00 each day. Finals only on the Monday. A number of "5 setters" on each day saw the last game finishing well beyond the scheduled 7.30pm!

Venue. Whilst providing the necessary 4 courts of reasonable standard; there is insufficient "run off" space on all sides. Some improvement can be made to 1 court. Other aspects of the venue are excellent. Geelong would appear to be the only venue with the ideal 4 court arrangement at present.

Referees: This is also the province of the VCV, but obviously the host is concerned that all runs well. Problems existed in preparing the Referees roster, in that, Associations didn't clearly indicate who would be available, or what other roles they had eg player coach etc. A number of Referees wore the correct attire but this should be mandatory from now on.

Publicity. - More could have been done but the following was achieved.

Before. Radio + TV sports news items only - no interviews.
Local Press - 1 article. Posters - schools, volleyball stadiums Morwell + Moe cars + shops.

During. Radio - 2 commercial stations plus ABC carried direct reports each evening for the 3 days + re-ran them the following mornings. 1 TV news + film on the Monday evening.

After local press article. (no photographer)

Sponsorship Virtually none was obtained due to a combination of two factors. The Association had already sought help 6 months earlier for the U'20's; lack of personnel to do the necessary work.

Results: A "Country 12" for men + women were selected by a panel composed of Murray Mansfield, Tomas Santamaria + Howard Williams. (see attachment.) Referees were graded by T. Santamaria




Dear Jenny,
