INTER ASSOCIATION TRANSFERS.

- . A player wishing to transfer to a club or team (hereinafter referred to as a club) affiliated with another Association must obtain a written clearance from the club he/she desires to leave, duly endorsed by the Association with which that club is affiliated.
- . The only exception to this rule is where the player has not played volleyball for a period of at least twelve months prior to the time of registering with the new club. Under such circumstances a clearance is not required.
- . The player shall present the approved clearance document to the new club for onforwarding to the Association with which that club is affiliated.
- . A player refused a clearance for any reason may appeal to the V.A.V.A. whose decision shall be final. An appeal must be in writing, have been endorsed by the Club and the Association to which the player wishes to transfer and be accompanied by a non-returnable fee of \$10.
- . It will be the responsibility of all Associations to ensure their Clubs observe transfer procedures. Any Association found guilty of allowing transfer regulations to be avoided shall be disciplined by the V.A.V.A. and fined no more than \$100 for the first offence and no more than \$200 for each offence thereafter.
