The VCVC have experienced a fairly quiet period during 1978 - 79, this being due to the Country Associations general satisfaction and also lack of interest in certain affairs.

The number of registered players throughout Country Victoria totalled 2,470. This being an increase of some 200 members gained by the addition of the Seymour Association to the VCVC.

The VAVA received an amount of \$5728.00 for the registration of these players.

The break up of players is as follows:-

Two divisions of Country Championships took place during 1979.

The U17 Country Championships were held at Wangaratta and the attendance of the VAVA U17 State Coaches was imperative, as a large number of players making up the U17 State teams now come from the Country.

These Championships have thus become virtual selection trials for Country players to enter State team ranks.

The Open Country Championships were conducted at Shepparton and invitations were again extended to the Vava State coaches to attend.

Those people who did attend as official representatives of the VAVA formed a panel to select VCVC Mens and Womens squads.

The players selected in these squads have been invited to participate in a series of matches against the South Australian CVC teams. These matches are to be held in Hamilton during the first weekend of December.

The State Director of Coaching has been very active in the Country areas and I feel we are only just starting to realise how invaluable his efforts have been, in the additions to our Junior ranks.

As a result of the re structure of the VAVA Constitution the Country Associations now have an equitable part to play in the top level administration of our game. It is expected that Country Victoria will continue to provide a burgeoning interest in all the affairs of the VAVA.
